### YANKEE HARBOUR, SOUTH SHETLAND ISLANDS

The main attraction for many visitors is Yankee's terraced Gentoo penguin colony with an estimated 4,000 breeding pairs. Predatory skuas also nest here and travellers are often witness to the struggle between a penguin protecting its young and a skua trying to feed theirs.

# Hippy days are here again...

It's day five of my river cruise on the Ganges in India with APT and I have been transported back to the 1960s. There on the path in front of me is a round-faced man in a plain white smock chanting the Hare Krishna mantra into a microphone attached to a cart pulled by a bicycle. And then my eye goes to those around him, his disciples, who look to have reached nirvana as they dance and join in with the chanting.

This is the scene at Mayapur, where the Krishna Consciousness Movement set up headquarters in 1972. It's a vast complex, filled with people who have decided to devote their minds to peace, love and raising money for an enormous temple that's under construction and would not look out of place in a James Bond movie.

It is the most extraordinary experience I have had on this cruise, and believe me it has had some stiff competition.

I've marvelled at the beautiful blooms on sale in the flower market in Kolkata while walking through thick mud (it was the end of monsoon season). I've said a silent prayer as my bus driver negotiated his way through cars, bikes and people going every which way on the city's chaotic roads. In Matiari village, I saw ladies queuing for fresh water at the pump, which is switched on for just two hours in the morning and two in the afternoon. It's a humbling experience given the endless supplies of clean bottled water provided back on my river boat, appropriately named Ganges Voyager.

APT launched this cruise at the start of 2015, offering either just seven nights sailing on the river round-trip from Kolkata or a 16 day holiday that starts with a tour of India's Golden Triangle (Delhi, Agra and Jaipur). Several of my fellow passengers (all Australian bar seven of us from the UK) did this, and also added a two night stay in Varanasi, said to be the oldest inhabited city in the world, at the end of the cruise.

The Ganges Voyager holds just 56 passengers and is a beautiful craft with heavy mahogany furniture and polished wooden floors. Lesson one during the welcome briefing was that all shoes had to be removed for cleaning as soon as we stepped back on board after an excursion, to help protect it from dirt and scratches.

She was built in Kolkata last year, and the wonderful crew could not do



enough to look after us, while enjoying the privilege of visiting a part of India where tourists are so rare that they become the main attraction.

As I was only doing the cruise, my journey started in Kolkata, the secondlargest city in India with a population of around 15 million, with another six or so million a day coming into the city to work. I think every one of them was on the road, either in a taxi, private car, rickshaw or buses that have seen better days, as we set out on our city tour.

The sights are interesting (the Victoria Memorial and Mother Teresa's home), but watching the people and the traffic were the highpoints for me, along with a crazy tram ride through the centre of town. We clanked along, doing battle with the other road users (they haven't quite got the idea of keeping off the tram tracks even though it has been there for nigh on a century) and constantly having to wait for the men in charge of the points to arrive with their steel bars and manually change the direction of the tracks.

The noise and chaos was all very different to the rest of the journey along the Ganges, India's most sacred river, some 2,525km long and so wide, that

when it floods during the monsoon you often can't see from one side to the other.

Although millions of people live along the river banks, they are in remote towns and villages where the main industries are agriculture and cottage industries. As we walked around the aforementioned Matiari, the peace and quiet of the village was broken by the rhythmic sound of the copper beaters bashing pots into shape.

During an exciting week, we rode in horse-drawn carts and trishaws (a pedal bike with a cart behind), visited crumbling mosques and impressive temples. At Shiva Temple, in the village of Kalna, we saw 108 shrines arranged in an outer and inner ring. We cruised past the site of the Battle of Plassey, where in 1757 Robert Clive of the British East India Company beat the Nawabs of Bengal and their French allies to take control of India. In Murshidabad, we toured the 19<sup>th</sup> century Hazarduari Palace, which allegedly has 1,000 doors. It's now a museum with an interesting array of old weapons, pictures and furniture.

In between trips ashore, there was plenty of cruising time, which was used for talks by the chef and the guides who accompanied the cruise. We learned about the spices used in Indian cooking, Hinduism, the benefits of yoga and the river itself, which Indians call Mother Ganga.

"She gives us water to drink and provides a transport system; she is a gift from heaven," one of the guides explained. So romantic but given 'she' is also one of the most-polluted rivers in the world I had no intention of testing what he called the 'life-giving' quality of her water. There was a reason why they gave us unlimited bottled water after all!

# Maritime Memories

with Nigel Lingard (Non-Executive Director, Reader Offers Ltd)

LOOKING AT ALL THE NEW 2017 CRUISE PROGRAMMES BEING LAUNCHED RECENTLY, I AM PLEASED TO SEE HOW MANY NEW PORTS OF CALL ARE BEING INCLUDED; SOME AS MAIDEN CALLS FOR THAT LINE OR SHIP, OTHERS BEING THE FIRST EVER VISIT BY ANY CRUISE SHIP.

The very high proportion of repeat travellers, many on their umpteenth cruise, does of course put pressure on the itinerary planners to come up with new ideas...however the modern regulatory and environmental ethos does mean that a lot of homework has to go into any decision to take a ship, especially a very big one, into new waters.

In the early days of the cruise industry's development we really did not have the resources to check every destination out in detail, so there was an element of "trust the local pilot" as ships made

their first approach. I recall a message from Black Prince's Master just after they had tied up in the little Danish port of Svendborg, advising that the channel was not quite as deep as the

charts showed, so he'd lost the tips of the propellors! On her first call to Banjul, on the Gambia River, the ship actually ran over the marker buoy where she was to wait for the pilot; a large tanker having rammed the buoy a day beforehand!

I do occasionally work with new ports

seeking introductions to the cruise ship operators, and I use such anecdotes to remind them of the importance of having reliable navigation data available, and to help them realise how long it may take to win that exciting first call.

Nowadays many of the ports we pioneered are regularly included in the planning process - for example the Cape Verde Islands which allowed us to extend traditional Canary cruises much further south into tropical sunshine. To this day my former colleagues at Fred. Olsen are still working with the island authorities to increase cruise call opportunities.

> I've been very impressed of late by the exciting developments at Silversea Cruises, the independently owned luxury cruise line which has now taken expedition cruising to a new level of excellence. With another new ship under construction, the fleet is now very wide ranging, including

sailings right from the Tower moorings in the heart of London!

Our own travel plans for the winter now include an expedition trip on a nine cabin river cruiser in the Amazon jungle, so ocean cruising will have to wait a bit longer!

# **Venison Stew**



PREP TIME -15 MINS

COOK TIME -2 HOURS

SERVES 8

# INGREDIENTS

- · 2 tbs vegetable oil
- · 1kg venison stew meat
- 3 onions, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, chopped
- 1 tbs Worcestershire sauce
- 1 bay leaf
- 1 tbs fresh thyme, chopped

- 750ml water
- 7 small potatoes, peeled and quartered
- 1 to 2 parsnips, peeled and chopped
- 2 tbs plain flour
- 4 tbs water



# METHOD

- 1. Heat oil in a large casserole or stockpot and brown the meat. Add onions, garlic, Worcestershire sauce, bay leaf, thyme, salt and 750ml water
- 2. Simmer, covered, for 11/2 2 hours, or until meat is tender
- Stir in potatoes and parsnips; cook until tender. Combine flour and remaining water. Stir into the stew to thicken slightly. Remove bay leaf before serving
