Mardi Gras

Mardi Gras - the mere mention of these two words convey thoughts of raucous celebrations, beads flying through the air and, of course, floats parading through the streets of New Orleans!

However, the origins of Mardi Gras can be traced back to medieval Europe, passing through Rome and Venice in the 17th and 18th centuries to the French House of the Bourbons. From these humble beginnings, each year thousands of people become honorary Creoles to celebrate Mardi Gras.

Mardi Gras, which in French translates as Fat Tuesday, is officially the day before Ash Wednesday. As the celebrations in America and across the world have grown larger with each passing year, Mardi Gras has evolved from one day into week long celebrations.

The New Orleans Carnival season starts on 6th January called "Twelfth Night" and a masked ball is held each year to mark the beginning of New Orleans' Carnival season.


Mardi Gras is about music, parades, picnics, floats and excitement and it's one big holiday in New Orleans! Revellers know to wear costumes or at least dress in purple (justice), green (faith), and gold (power), adorning themselves with long beads caught from the floats of previous parades. The significance of the colours was selected by Rex, the King of Carnival, in 1892.



brand new Cruise & Maritime 2016/17 launch promotion).





ave you ever wondered what would have happened to cruises around the United Kingdom if Scotland had voted to break up the union last year? Probably not a question top of most people's minds at the time of the referendum, but it would have been interesting.

ould we, for instance, have had to go through passport control to enter the new country (after all it was not a given that it would be allowed to stay in the EU)? Fred. Olsen would have had to rethink its new policy of allowing folk to board cruises around the UK using a driving licence or council-issued bus pass for ID instead of insisting on a passport. And for sure, itineraries with 'UK' in the title would have to have been renamed.

Happily none of this came to pass and for the foreseeable future at least the union is safe and we can continue to cruise around the British Isles as we have always done. I'm delighted because I reckon a round-Britain cruise is the best way to see the UK - or at any rate the bits that are close to water.

I have only done it once but visited so many interesting places and sights I have heard of but never seen (the Ring of Brodgar in the Orkney Islands, Edinburgh, the Giant's Causeway in

Northern Ireland), and without the hassle of unpacking, the worry of traffic jams or the expense of staying in a hotel and eating out. Because you are on a ship, you feel you have been abroad, but to top it all, I didn't have to change money (well you do need euros for Ireland but you can get by with a credit card).

And why am I telling you all this? Because in 2016 two companies, MSC Cruises and Disney Cruise Line are sailing around the UK for the first time, while luxury line Crystal has its first round-Britain cruise for a few years. Crystal's cruise is in July, round-trip from Tilbury, and has overnights in Dublin and Edinburgh so there's lots of time to see both cities. MSC's cruise is in May, round-trip from Southampton on MSC Splendida, and includes a day in Hamburg.

One of the notable trends in round-Britain cruising is that many itineraries no longer actually go around the UK, but concentrate instead on the west coast.

Fred. Olsen has a debut Britain Isles cruise from Falmouth next April - a 10 night voyage on Boudicca - that sails the west coast of the UK to Kirkwall in the Orkney Islands and returns the same way.

Swan Hellenic also hugs the west coast with a 12 day cruise round-trip from Portsmouth next July that ticks off little-known ports including Lamlash in the Isle of Arran, Douglas in the Isle of Man and Waterford in Ireland. And so does Seabourn, which is flying the flag for the Union on a 16 day cruise from Dover next August that visits England, Scotland, Ireland and Wales.

But circumnavigators have not been left out. Fred. Olsen also has several cruises round-Britain including a veritable castle-fest on Balmoral next June. The cruise is from Newcastle and there's a fortress at almost every port, from Castle Cornet in Guernsey to St. Michael's Mount in Marazion, Cornwall.



rist there were the Beatles, then there were the three Queens. I am talking about Liverpool, of course, where Cunard's Queen Mary 2, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth 'met' for the first time in May.

It was all part of the company's anniversary celebrations - 175 years since Samuel Cunard launched his first voyage across the Atlantic - and an incredible event. The three ships sailed into the river, made a synchronised turn and then pulled up one next to the other as the Red Arrows flew over.

I was watching from the Birkenhead side of the river and could not believe the thousands of sightseers who turned out to see the event. Roads were blocked on both sides of the river, the waterfronts were packed. Some younger people, longer hair and a few more tears and it would have been just like the Beatles arriving in the US for the first time! OK, that's a bit of poetic licence but you get the picture.

Seeing all three Queens on the Mersey really was a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity as Cunard quit Liverpool in favour of Southampton nearly 50 years ago (apparently the May event took four years to organise!), but the city will be figuring in the company's on-going 175th anniversary celebrations one more time this year.

On 4th July, Queen Mary 2 sails from Liverpool en route to Halifax in Canada and Boston in the US, exactly 175 years after Cunard's first ship, Britannia, set off on her maiden transatlantic crossing from the city. There will only be one Queen but I bet the folk of Liverpool will be out in force once again.





Pulled Pork & Spicy Coleslaw

FOOD FOR THOUGHT:
PULLED PORK &
SPICY COLESLAW



PREP - 30 MINS COOK - 4 HRS

SERVES 6-8

FOR THE PORK:

- · 2kg (4lbs) of pork shoulder
- 3 onions, julienned
- · 6 cloves of garlic, chopped
- 250ml cider
- 200ml white wine vinegar
- 1 tbsp chilli flakes
- · 1 tbsp wholegrain mustard
- · Oil for greasing
- Salt and pepper to taste
- · Parchment paper, foil

FOR THE COLESLAW

- · Half white cabbage, finely sliced
- · 2 red onions, julienned
- · 2 carrots, grated
- · 1 red chilli, deseeded and finely chopped
- · The juice of one lime
- 175g mayonnaise
- 1 tbsp soy sauce
- · Salt and pepper to taste

METHOD

- Preheat oven to 170°C/340°F/Gas Mark 3.
- 2. Combine the mustard and chilli with the salt and pepper then massage onto the pork shoulder.
- Grease a baking tray and place the pork shoulder onto it. Pour over the cider and vinegar. Take the sliced onion and garlic and scatter over.
- Cover with parchment paper before wrapping in foil and place in the oven, roasting for three hours.
- Remove the foil and parchment, then roast for another hour.
- Once removed from the oven, you can now pull the pork by sticking one fork in the shoulder and using a second fork to shred the meat.
- Mix together all of the coleslaw ingredients in a separate bowl until well combined.
- Heap a serving of the coleslaw on a plate and pile the pulled pork next to it. Serve with fresh bread and barbecue sauce if desired.
