Last month, Direct Marketing Team Leader, Helen Smith was lucky enough to enjoy a four night educational trip aboard APT's AmaVerde

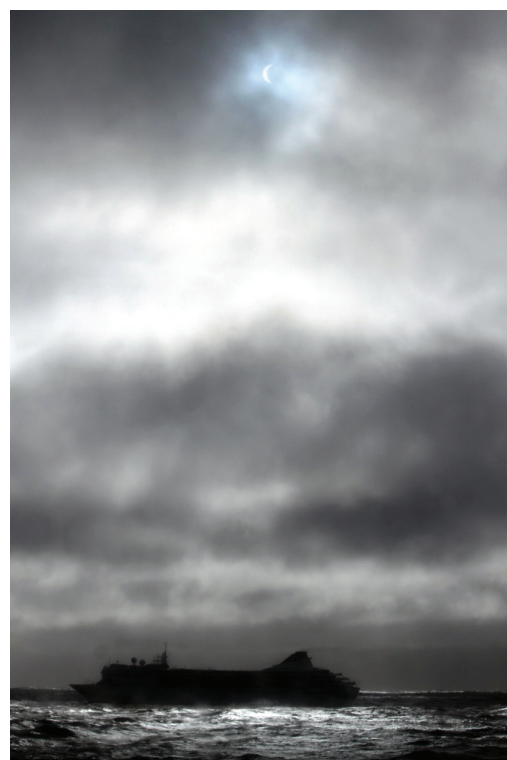

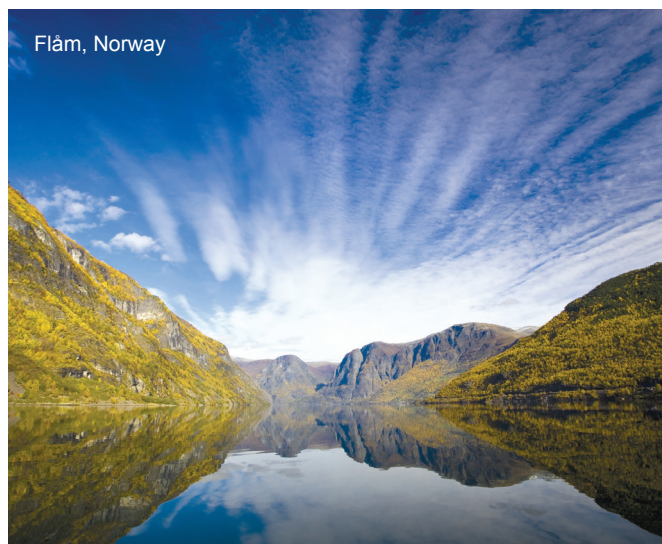

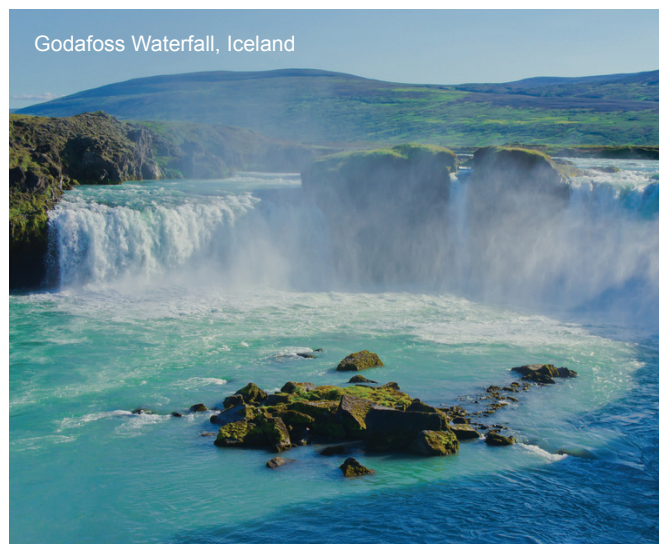

The Elephant of Nantes

What do the Chelsea Flower Show and Swan Hellenic have in common? If you know the answer you have probably seen Swan's selection of new cruises from the UK for next summer.

There are some great new itineraries, including a voyage to Iceland with a chance to go whale-watching and a cruise around the UK that is in Edinburgh for the Military Tattoo. The trip to the Chelsea Flower Show is from Greenwich in London, where Minerva will moor after a showcase cruise back and forth under Tower Bridge.

Swan is also helping blur the lines between ocean and river cruising with a voyage that takes Minerva up the Seine, Loire and Garonne Rivers in France, with overnight stays in Nantes and Bordeaux.

They are lovely cities, with historical centres and fabulous architecture. In Nantes, they have a giant mechanical elephant that walks and trumpets and a huge carousel that looks Victorian but was only built in 2012. They are both

part of an urban regeneration project on land that was a shipyard until 1987.

Swan also has an epic 30 day voyage to the White Sea in Russia that includes a visit to Archangel, Murmansk and the Solovetsky Islands. The cruise is round-trip from Portsmouth with lots of stops along the Norwegian coast, but if that's too long and you don't mind flying, it's also available as an 18 night voyage from Kirkenes to the White Sea and back to Portsmouth.

There are a few novel no-fly cruises from the UK next year. Swan's sister line Voyages of Discovery is sailing around Britain but only visiting our islands - seven in all, from Kirkwall in the north to the Isles of Scilly in the south-west.

MSC Cruises, it seems, just can't keep

away. Having just pulled out of the UK, it is not only back in 2016 with a mini-season of no-fly cruises from Southampton, but positioning one of its biggest ships here.

MSC Splendida has all the usual features you'd expect from a modern ship - swimming pools, kids' clubs, numerous bars and lounges - but it also has an ace up its sleeve. The Yacht Club. I am a huge fan of this peaceful haven, which comes with 24-hour service from some of the best butlers on the high seas, and an exclusive lounge, private deck space and restaurant. If you are cruising with MSC, there is no other way to travel.

The ship is sailing Northern Europe's coastline - Amsterdam, Zeebrugge, Hamburg and Le Havre - but MSC is also offering its first no-fly cruise round the UK - Scotland, Ireland and a day in Hamburg.



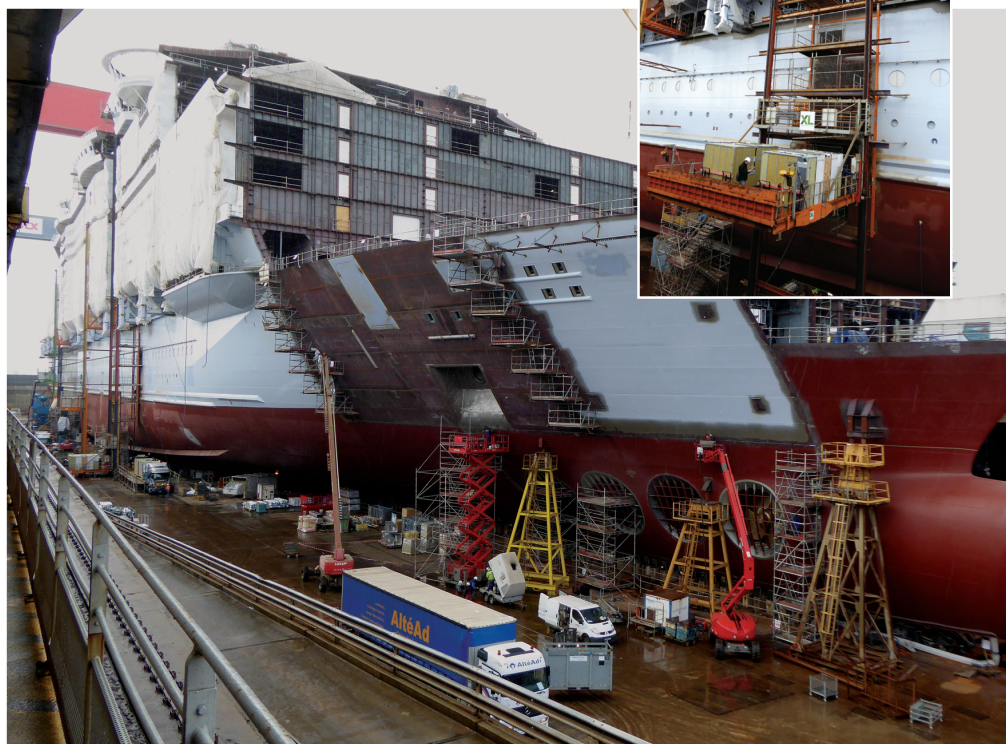

Not only is she now recognisable as a cruise ship, but she has a name. Meet Harmony of the Seas, launching in spring 2016. The good news is that she will be hanging around on this side of the Pond for the summer, sailing seven-night cruises round-trip from Barcelona or Civitavecchia before going in search of winter sun in Florida and the Caribbean in October.

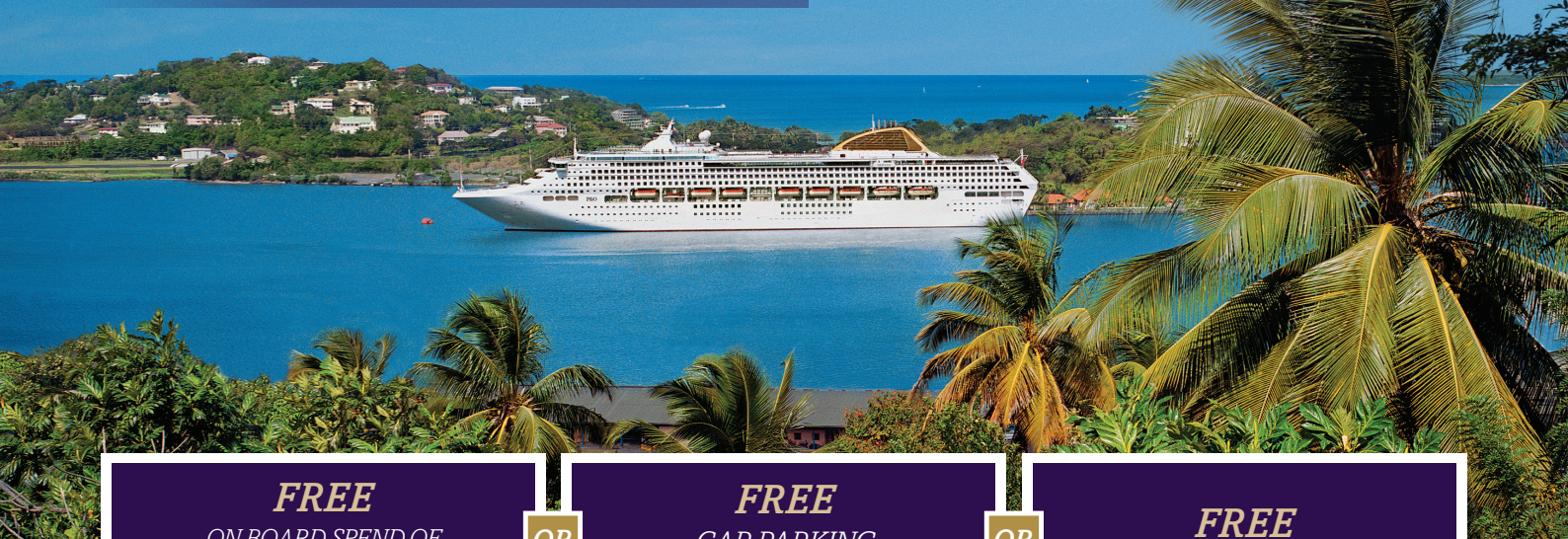

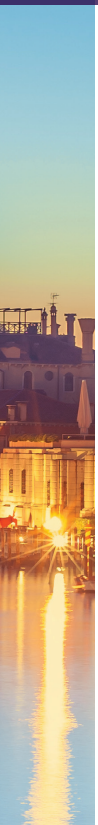

Maritime Memories

DURING APRIL WE WERE PRIVILEGED TO BE GUESTS AT THE NAMING CEREMONY FOR ROYAL CARIBBEAN'S NEWEST ADDITION, ANTHEM OF THE SEAS, THEN STAYING ON FOR A TWO NIGHT INAUGURAL CRUISE.

These new ships never cease to amaze me, and the Royal Caribbean group are the clear leaders in design innovation. Although the vessel is absolutely enormous, modern designers have mastered the flow of guests so that you never feel too much part of a crowd, despite the potential capacity for 4,900 companions on board!

The product is aimed at a younger market - families and middle-aged couples primarily, and this is reflected in the quite astonishing entertainment we enjoyed. The Royal Theatre, which puts most London venues to shame, hosted a sensational performance of the Ben Elton penned musical "We Will Rock You", whilst the smaller Music Hall featured comedy and live music.

Most amazing was the Two70 theatre, although that is too restrictive a word for this complex space. Artists appear rising from the floor or descending from the ceiling; robotic screens generate images as they soar above; whilst a 105ft wide background shows dramatic images. The show we saw, "Spectra's Cabaret", really took our breath away - quite an admission for someone as cynical as me about entertainment!

Daytime activities are just as exciting, with Royal Caribbean's new concepts like rock-wall climbing and flow-rider surfing now positively old hat! Welcome to the new world of weightless floating in a wind tunnel, or flying 300ft over the sea in a space capsule, followed by trapeze wire lessons, roller skating disco or a spin on the dodgems!

We only managed to sample a few of the 18 different dining and bar facilities around the ship, but clearly this is a floating resort that can be a holiday in itself, whatever the weather and wherever the destinations.

ALTHOUGH THE VESSEL IS ABSOLUTELY ENORMOUS, MODERN DESIGNERS HAVE MASTERED THE FLOW OF GUESTS

For those to whom all this sounds just too hectic (and it is difficult to find a quiet corner), the same company do of course have alternative cruise brands. The Celebrity ships have modern concepts, and really beautifully appointed accommodation, but a rather more sedate feel better suited to those of us who are maybe past our karaoke days! The dress code on board is also more relaxed than traditional British lines - and there's a lot to be said for not needing to take the black tie outfit when

joining a fly-cruise.

Also in the same family of brands is the Azamara fleet...smaller ships with just a few hundred fellow guests. Their five

star luxury approach and a destination focused choice of itineraries have built up a very loyal following. (See pages 46-47 for your chance to experience their unique more inclusive cruising).

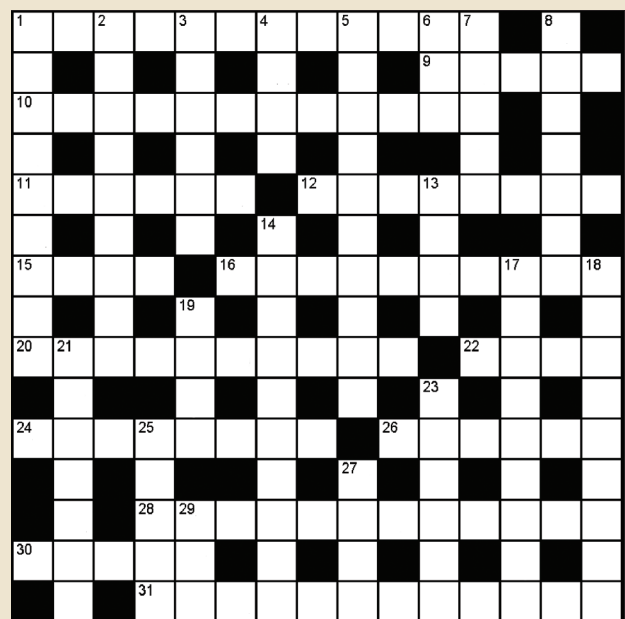

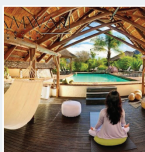

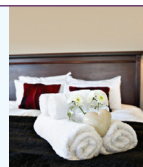

South African Pear & Toffee Muffin



PREP - 10 MINS
COOK - 30 MINS

MAKES 12

INGREDIENTS

- 300g self-raising flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 2 tsp ground cinnamon
- 85g golden caster sugar
- 250ml milk
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 100g butter, melted
- 2 ripe Williams or Packhams pears, peeled and cut into small chunks
- 100g soft toffees, chopped

METHOD

1. Preheat oven to 200°C/180°C fan/gas 6. Place your paper cupcake cases into a cupcake baking tray.
2. In a large bowl, mix the flour and baking powder with the cinnamon and a pinch of salt. Stir in the sugar.
3. Mix the eggs, milk and melted butter in a jug and pour into the dry mix, together with the pears and a third of the toffee pieces.
4. Combine by stirring - you want the batter to be a little lumpy with streaks of flour.
5. Swiftly scoop an even amount of the mixture into each cupcake well, roughly two-thirds full. Divide the remaining toffee and accessorise the tops.
6. Bake for 25-30 minutes. The muffins should have risen, look golden and feel firm when pressed (without touching the molten-hot toffee).
7. Remove your cakes and allow to cool on a wire rack.
