



TWO INTO THREE DOES GO!

CHALK AND CHEESE WERE ON MY MIND AS IN THE SPACE OF THREE DAYS IN MARCH I SAW THE QUEEN NAME P&O CRUISES' NEW SHIP BRITANNIA AND GLORIA HUNNIFORD UNVEIL A PLAQUE ON MAGELLAN, THE FORMER CARNIVAL VESSEL THAT MOST RECENTLY SAILED FOR IBERO CRUCEROS (A CARNIVAL BRAND NOW ABSORBED BY COSTA CRUISES LAST YEAR) AND HAS NOW JOINED CRUISE AND MARITIME VOYAGES' FLEET.

The two events could not have been more different. P&O laid on a very British celebration that celebrated all four corners of the UK - the bands of the Royal Marines and Irish Guards, the Red Hot Chilli Pipers (think bagpipes as you have never heard them before) and comedian Rob Brydon, the new face of P&O (who just happens to come from Swansea!)

P&O took a risk by staging the event outside and was lucky to get a cool but sunny day. CMV took no chances, instead holding a low-key celebration in Magellan's show lounge.

The two vessels being named were also oceans apart. Britannia, with capacity for 3,647 passengers, named to underline P&O's British roots; Magellan, holding just 1,250 passengers, named after a 15th century Portuguese explorer. Britannia new, of course, and more boutique hotel (and dare I say Celebrity) than P&O ship, with a modern look and feel that flows throughout the ship; Magellan, looking smart after a near €70 million refit in 2010 but still very much a child of the '80s with lots of brass, glass and outside space, and beautiful teak decking.

For me, the standout features on Britannia were the white atrium with its Starburst centrepiece, and the Horizon Court buffet, which has a stylish combination of light wood and chrome decor. It's a large area divided into two serving areas, each with four identical serving counters, which should help to reduce queues.

I also liked the way P&O has grouped the single cabins together (there are 12 inside and 15 with a balcony) along one corridor on Lido deck 16 along from the Crows Nest. It's not quite up there with the singles' lounge on Norwegian Cruise Line's newest ships but it does make it easy for people travelling alone to get to know others cruising on their own and means they have somewhere on their 'doorstep' if they want to get together for drinks and a chat.

P&O CRUISES

The new cookery school was looking good and I imagine it will be popular, especially when the likes of Mary Berry and Antonio Carluccio are giving the classes (the folk at Reader Offers will be able to let you have the dates when the celebrity chefs are on board); personally I'd rather be eating than cooking, especially if I'm in Sindhu, the Indian restaurant created by Atul Kochhar.

Sadly I didn't get to dine there when I was on board but Atul's starter for the gala dinner the evening before





the christening was the best dish on the menu - just too small! - so I know I would not be disappointed.

As Magellan had that big refurb five years ago, Cruise and Maritime hasn't made any changes since taking delivery other than changing the name (it was most recently called Grand Holiday), the livery on the funnel and the names of the lounges.

Any other alterations will come once CMV's chiefs see how well each of the areas gel with the company's passengers. I suspect most areas will remain intact but the casino could be an early casualty - slimmed down rather than got rid of altogether as the Brits are not known as high rollers. But who knows? Maybe CMV's passengers will discover a gambling addiction! For me, the best bits of the ship were the cosy Sinatra Bar and Raffles, the self-service restaurant, which was well laid out with individual service stations, and the Jade Spa.

This is a much bigger facility than you'd usually find on a vessel of this age, with six treatment rooms and a thermal suite with sauna and steam rooms. I gather it was expanded during the refit because the Spanish love their spas. With sea shell and honey massages among treatments, I can understand why!

I was also impressed with the suites on deck 11. They are the only cabins on the ship with balconies and also the only ones I saw with a double bed configuration. Bar a handful on decks four, five and six, all other cabins are laid out in a twin bed configuration, but they can be put together on request.



Curry-Mango Shrimp on the Barbie

SYNONYMOUS WITH POPULAR SOUND BITES SUCH AS "PLAY IT AGAIN, SAM" IS THAT ENDEARING PHRASAL PARODY OF AUSTRALIA "THROW ANOTHER SHRIMP ON THE BARBIE."

Needless to say, the Australians are connoisseurs of crustaceans, and they're not shy of seasoning. This particular dish stacks flavour on a stick, is low in fat, pure protein, and simple to rustle up. What's more, you don't need colonial climes to grill outside, since a cast iron griddle pan can give you that charcoaled kick come rain or shine. And while not all of us can spear our shrimp fresh from the surf, there's plenty of fresh-frozen prawns on ice at the mongers.

All you need now are some metal skewers, a blend of spices and a gathering of good vibes. When it comes to second servings, you'll need to throw on more than just the one, mate.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 pound of peeled and deveined large shrimp or king prawns (roughly ½ pound per person for a main course)
- 1 lime (or enough for 3 tablespoons of juice)
- 1 tablespoon fresh finely-grated ginger
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1/2 cup mango chutney
- 1/2 teaspoon curry powder
- Metal skewers

PREPARATION

- Combine the ginger, oil, curry powder, chutney and lime in a bowl.
- Brush half of this mixture over the shrimp/prawns. If you want more flavour, cook the shrimp with their heads intact. Cover and stand for 15 minutes.
- 3. If cooking with a griddle, grease it with a little oil and pre-heat to a medium temperature; you don't want to overcook the shrimp. In the meantime, thread the shrimp onto skewers. If you want to keep their attractive curved shape, skewer each one through the head and bottom near the tail. Do not pack the shrimp too tightly to ensure even cooking.
- Grill the shrimp, leaving them to sizzle for 3 or 4 minutes each side. They are ready when the skin turns pink. Remove immediately from heat.
- 5. Brush with the remaining chutney mixture and serve.





INDEPENDENCE DAY ****

In 1775, the people of New England began fighting the British for their independence and on 2nd July 1776, the Congress secretly voted for independence from Great Britain. The Declaration of Independence was first published two days later on 4th July, 1776, but wasn't actually signed until a month later.

The first description of how Independence Day would be celebrated was in a letter from John Adams to his wife Abigail on 3rd July 1776. He described "pomp and parade, with shows, games, sports, guns, bells, bonfires, and illuminations" throughout the United States. However, the term "Independence Day" was not used until 1791.

Commonly known as the Fourth of July, today Independence Day is a federal holiday in the United States where celebrations include fireworks, parades, barbecues, carnivals, sports games and much more.

Interestingly, Thomas Jefferson and John Adams, both signers of the Declaration of Independence and presidents of the United States, died on 4th July 1826 - exactly 50 years after the adoption of the declaration.







LAST MONTH'S EDITION MENTIONED DEAR OLD ''BLACK PRINCE'', SO I THOUGHT IT TIMELY TO UPDATE HER STORY WHICH I'M AFRAID TO SAY HAS REACHED A SAD ENDING.

During the 1950s and 1960s the Olsen family had been busy rebuilding their fleet of ships which had been decimated during the Second World War; many having been destroyed by allied action in order to prevent them falling into German hands as Norway was occupied.

The new Black Prince and sister ship Black Watch were to be quite revolutionary, fulfilling mixed roles suited to the Olsen's world-wide business activities. In the summer tourist season the ships would serve as drive-on car ferries linking the UK with Norway, offering new innovations such as air



conditioning and en suite bathrooms for every cabin.

In the winter the vessels were switched to routes linking England and Holland with the Canary Islands, where the family had extensive banana and tomato growing operations. The car decks became a chilled storage area for palletised fruit on the northbound journey, with mixed freight carried southbound. Upstairs the passenger areas were PLA

adapted to a cruise mode, with 350 passengers enjoying 12 night winter sunshine holidays.



than successful, so it was back to the traditional British market!

Sadly the 2008 economic downturn, coming just when Balmoral was due into service, led to the decision to sell Black Prince, so in 2009 she headed off to a new life in Venezuela. This was dogged by bureaucratic problems, and the ship

BLACK PRINCE PLAYED A KEY ROLE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE CRUISE BUSINESS was sent to Haiti for relief work after their earthquake disaster. Subsequently she was laid up in Santo Domingo, Dominica...and now my contacts there tell me that she was broken up last year.

Black Prince played a key

role in the development of the cruise business as we know it today, and I was able to see how far this has come when visiting P&O's "Britannia" on her inauguration. Wow! Twelve times the size, and outfitted like a luxury hotel resort... but I do miss that little ship!
