



## Swanning about in the Med



*One of the things I love about the ancient Greeks is the way they had a god for everything. We are all familiar with Hades, who guarded the underworld, Aphrodite, the goddess of love, and Hermes, the winged messenger.*

**B**ut who'd have thought there was a god of medicine? His name was Asclepius and I learned all about him this summer on an excursion from Dikili to the ancient city Pergamon - once an important Greek city, now in Turkey - on a cruise from Istanbul to Piraeus.

The ruins of Upper Pergamon (where the important people lived) are high on a hill and reached by cable car; at the foot of the Acropolis was the Askleion, dubbed the world's first medical centre, where people bathed in sacred springs and dreamt that Asclepius appeared and told them how to cure their illness (that water must have been good stuff!).

I mention this partly to highlight what interesting things you can learn on a cruise in the Mediterranean, but also because it gives me a neat link to Swan Hellenic, which recently announced it will be spending winter 2016-17 in Europe instead of following the sun to Asia or South America.

And one of the ports it will be calling at is Dikili, for an excursion to Pergamon. Actually Minerva, Swan Hellenic's 350-passenger ship, will be there twice - once on a cruise from Piraeus, the port for Athens, to Larnaca in Cyprus, and then again on a voyage back to Piraeus.

She will also be cruising through the narrow 70-foot-wide Corinth Canal, calling at Naples for a tour to Naples and Livorno for an excursion to Florence. A 14 day voyage in December from Civitavecchia (where she stays overnight so there is time to see Rome) spends Christmas Eve in Cagliari in Sardinia and New Year's Eve in Barcelona, and the cruise ends with a night in Marseilles so there is time for everyone to go to Avignon.

It's a really appealing Christmas getaway, especially with the trip to Avignon at the end. I visited the city for the first time this summer and it is a fabulous place. It was home to six popes between 1309 and 1377 (that's when they returned to Rome), and their residency, the Palais des

Papes, is stunning - 11<sup>th</sup> century and one of the largest Gothic buildings in Europe.

Of course you also have to see the famous Pont d'Avignon (real name Pont Saint-Bénézet) which was actually abandoned in the 17<sup>th</sup> century and ever since it has been slowly destroyed by floods. You can still go on the bridge (a ticket costs €4) but there are just four arches left.

The benefit of cruising the Mediterranean in winter is that the crowds will have gone - if you join Swan Hellenic's excursion to Pompeii you will be able to see the ruins rather than just groups of tourists! - as will the summer heat. It was around 35°C in Avignon and Pergamon, which I loved, but others on my cruises found unbearable.

Best of all, as Swan includes excursions in the cost of the cruise, you can go on all the tours without worrying about the budget. In fact the only thing you do need to worry about is which cruise to choose. I know I would struggle.



You know autumn is on the way when P&O Cruises and Cunard release details of the round-the-world voyages they are offering from Southampton in January 2017

P&O is playing the heritage card by linking Aurora's world cruise to the company's 180<sup>th</sup> anniversary and the old trade routes of the British Empire. That takes her through the Middle East to India, Asia and on to Australia, from where she returns via the South Pacific and Panama Canal.

In line with the new cruise trend of lingering longer, she'll be staying overnight in Dubai, Singapore, Sydney and San Francisco so passengers can have more time ashore.

Cunard's 120 day world voyage on Queen Victoria also caught my eye because she'll be making history by becoming the largest ship to cruise up the Amazon. She is sailing non-stop from Barbados to Manaus, but stopping at Santarém on the way back to the Atlantic.

It's too early for Cunard to have organised excursions but popular ones include jungle hikes and fishing for carnivorous piranhas. It gives a whole new meaning to the idea of trying to get a bite!

## *Let there be light*

Hurtigruten is so confident its passengers will see the Northern Lights on one of its 12 day Norwegian coastal voyages this winter that it has pledged to give a free one-week cruise to anyone who doesn't see them.

As I have been to Norway several times in winter and never seen the light, or Aurora Borealis to give them their proper name, I am tempted to put the promise to the test. Not because I want the free cruise but because I'd love to see the lights and I reckon they must have a hotline to 'him upstairs' to make sure they don't have to giveaway too many trips!

I jest of course, but I did check back with Hurtigruten, as they had a similar promise last year. Apparently out of everyone who travelled on a 12 day Bergen-Kirkenes-Bergen round-trip last winter, just one couple qualified for the free cruise. The odds of seeing the lights are in your favour.




## INDIA





# Maritime Memories

with Nigel Lingard

THIS AUTUMN IT HAS BEEN THE TURN OF HAMBURG TO HOST THE CRUISE INDUSTRY'S ANNUAL SEATRADE CRUISE CONFERENCE, WHICH ALTERNATES ANNUALLY BETWEEN SOUTHERN AND NORTHERN EUROPEAN CITIES.

Hamburg has enjoyed a remarkable period of growth in terms of cruise ship calls; both by visiting ships and by those actually based in the city. Regular visitors include Cunard's great liner QM2, which makes a long detour from Southampton in order to offer transatlantic voyages for German passengers. The ship is much loved in the port, and makes a fantastic sight when she is dry-docked near the heart of the city for regular overhauls.

The port hosts a "Cruise Days" festival every second year, culminating in a parade of some 150 ships down the River Elbe, led by several cruise liners. Waterside buildings are all spectacularly illuminated for the occasion, and a

quarter of a million spectators line the riverside with a real party atmosphere - barbecues, live bands, street theatre and floating bars!

Between Hamburg and the Dutch border lies the small town of Papenburg - home to the vast Meyer Werft shipyard. Curiously, the location is over 30 miles inland, accessed via the narrow Weser-Ems Canal. New ships have to be very carefully towed out to the sea in what becomes another major sightseeing event. The yard is famed for its high quality workmanship, which is exemplified in the latest Celebrity Cruises vessels. These innovative ships are real trend-setters, and feature the most immaculate cabins I have seen in a premium ship. See pages 32-39 for Celebrity Cruises Modern Luxury voyages.

We've looked before at how the big four cruise ship owning groups (Carnival, Royal Caribbean, Norwegian and MSC) are dominating the new ship orderbook, but of course the smaller companies

also need to keep updating their fleets. A recent step on this front has been Hurtigruten's successful purchase of another cruise-ferry to be adapted for their Norwegian coastal and Arctic expedition services. This latter activity, pioneered with the sturdy little "Fram", has been very successful; hence the need to expand. See pages 20-21 to sail on board MS Spitsbergen during her maiden season.

There was much discussion at the Seatrade event about where the operators of smaller cruise ships are going to find replacement or additional vessels when the newbuildings are all from 2,000 to 5,000+ passenger capacity.

Fingers crossed that we will continue to resolve these issues somehow...






# Chicken Laksa



**TOTAL TIME -**  
1 HOUR

*SERVES 4-6*

## INGREDIENTS

- 2 tbsp coriander seeds
- 1 tsp black peppercorns
- 1 tsp cumin seeds
- 1 tsp fennel seeds
- 4 cloves
- ¼ tsp ground turmeric
- 5 to 8 dried arbol chillies, stemmed
- 2 lemongrass stalks
- 3 tbs vegetable oil
- 450g boned, skinned chicken thighs, cubed
- 1 tsp shrimp paste
- 3 large shallots, thinly sliced
- 1 can (400ml) coconut milk
- 1 ltr chicken stock
- 2 tsp sugar
- 3 tsp salt
- 1 cinnamon stick
- 170g mung bean sprouts, rinsed
- 225g wide rice noodles
- ½ cup fresh mint leaves, torn
- ½ cup fresh coriander leaves, torn
- Lime wedges

## METHOD

1. Grind coriander seeds, peppercorns, cumin, fennel, cloves, turmeric, and chillies coarsely in a spice grinder. Peel tough outer layers from lemongrass, then mash core with a meat mallet or rolling pin
2. Heat oil in a large pot over medium heat. Add chicken, shrimp paste, shallots and reserved spices, and cook, stirring constantly, until fragrant (2 mins)
3. Pour in coconut milk, stock, sugar and salt; add cinnamon and lemongrass. Bring to a boil, then simmer, covered (20 mins)
4. Boil bean sprouts in a large pot of boiling water until softened (2 mins). Transfer to a bowl. Add noodles to pot and cook until firm (4 mins). Drain; rinse well
5. Divide bean sprouts and noodles among six bowls. Ladle in soup (remove cinnamon and lemongrass) and top with mint and coriander. Serve with limes and chilli
