Built from 1904 to 1914, the Panama Canal measures 52 miles and joining the Atlantic Ocean and the Pacific Ocean, it is an integral part of any voyage to the Central American region.

From the Canal's opening day to present, nearly a million ships have passed through the mighty locks. Encompassing tragedy and triumph, Spanish kings, conquistadors and five different American presidents, the building of this massive project spanned 400 years. And today, over 100 years after its completion, the Panama Canal remains one of the most vital trade routes in the world.

What makes the Panama Canal remarkable is its self sufficiency. The dam at Gatun, is able to generate the electricity to run all the motors which operate the canal as well as the locomotives in charge of towing the ships through the canal. No force is required to adjust the water level between the locks except gravity. As the lock operates, the water simply flows into the locks from the lakes or flows out to the sea level channels. The canal also relies on the overabundant rainfall of the area to compensate for the loss of the 52 million gallons of fresh water consumed during each crossing.

Although the crossing takes nine hours to complete, it is still the quickest link between the Atlantic and the Pacific - while also being the most beautiful. On a passage from Balboa, on the Pacific coast, a series of locks ascend to Miraflores Lake. Through the Culebra Cut it continues into Gatun Lake where the Soberania National Park, possibly the most accessible rainforest in the world and resplendent with exotic birdlife, can be found. The channel then narrows and passes the Americas Interoceanic National Park before passing close to the ruined forts of Portobelo and San Lorenzo, UNESCO

World Heritage Sites, and into the Atlantic.

The sights on either side of your ship, the knowledge of the Panama Canal's creation and the wonderful destinations on the fringes of two of the world's great oceans make this one experience that is guaranteed to never be forgotten. HEADING TO Alabana



EN EL FLORIDITA

ONCE THE US AND CUBA STARTED TO TALK AT THE END OF LAST YEAR, IT WAS NEVER Going to be long before the mainstream cruise lines started to plan visiting the Island. But who'd have thought the first to go would be MSC, followed just a few months later by carnival corporation.

SC was a surprise, but only because the company has spoken so much of the Mediterranean, Gulf and cracking America with its first Sunshine ship that it never occurred to me to think they were looking Cuba's way.

Carnival though? Now that was a shock - not the fact the company wants to go there, because Americans have been hankering to set foot on the island for years, but it has managed to get the green light to visit before the US travel ban to Cuba has been lifted. Amazingly it has been in place for around 50 years.

It's all thanks to Adonia, the soon-to-bemuch-missed P&O ship that is moving to fathom, the new [all lower case] cruise line Carnival is launching next April. Because the new brand is aimed at travellers who will be using their skills to help people in poorer countries (socalled volunteerism), the US government has granted it a license to go to Cuba.

At the time of writing, fathom's itinerary hasn't been finalised, but it will be starting the Cuba runs in May 2016 and I imagine it will include at least two days in Havana. It would be really great if it also visits one of Cuba's other cities, or even Antilla, on the north-east coast, where the volunteers can lend their time and skills to help country folk.

Either way, that both lines will be taking visitors to Cuba is fantastic news for the local people, who hopefully will benefit financially from the influx of tourists but also manage to continue to govern their own future and retain their culture despite the power of the Yankee dollar. I have visited Cuba twice, most recently in February, and it is a wonderful place. You can walk around without being hassled and the streets are full of local restaurants and shops rather than being overrun by cheap t-shirt emporiums, Starbucks or McDonalds.

Happily there is a lot more to Cuba than shopping. I had three glorious days getting to know Havana and its beautiful colonial architecture. I took a ride in one of the 1950 American cars that these days do service as taxis, and was shaken around in a yellow tuk-tuk, known locally as a Coco taxi.

I learned how to make rum and roll cigars (don't think I'll ever be as fast as the ladies who churn out hundreds of smokes a day), and of course I had to have a mojito (or two!) in Floridita, one





of US author Ernest Hemmingway's favourite bars. It's actually where he went for a daiquiri but I'm not a fan of that particular beverage.

MSC will be basing MSC Opera in Havana, and staying overnight in the city so passengers have two and a half days to explore. The ship, which has more balcony cabins and flexible dining options after being 'stretched' during a two-month dry-dock this summer, will also be calling at Montego Bay in Jamaica, Cozumel in Mexico and Georgetown in Cayman Islands.

It's a great itinerary, but would be even better if it extended the Cuba bit of the cruise because the cities of Santiago de Cuba, the seat of the revolution, and Cienfuegos, founded by the French, are really worth a visit. Just saying...

OH I DO LIKE TO BE BESIDE THE SEASIDE

I know it is a bit geeky, but I love shipyard visits, either to see the start of a newbuild or touring the shell of a vessel when it is floated out for the first time.

So I was in my element in June, when I joined the bosses of MSC Cruises at the Fincantieri shipyard in Monfalcone, Italy, to watch the sparks fly as the first piece of steel was cut for the company's new-generation MSC Seaside.

The giant vessel - she holds just over 5,000 passengers - launches in November 2017 and will be based year-round in Miami to spearhead MSC's breakthrough into the American market (they do sail from the US now, but have never managed to become a household name there).

In line with the cruise line trend to 'reconnect passengers with the sea', her restaurants will have both inside and outside seating areas. She will also have new family suites, an exclusive Yacht Club and an aqua park with five water slides.

A TASTE OF LUXURY

The rumours have finally come true and Silversea has ordered a new ship. The company didn't give much away in its announcement, just that the new ship will be called Silver Muse, hold 596 passengers and launch in spring 2017. Silversea fans must be delighted. The ship has been such a long time coming - the last Silversea newbie was Silver Spirit in 2009 - that I think it has been left behind the curve by luxury rivals Seabourn and Regent Seven Seas Cruises. Both these companies placed orders for

new builds some time ago, in the process promising tonnage that would be bigger and better than anything we have seen so far in the ultra-luxury market. In fact, Regent has gone so far as to claim that the new Seven Seas Explorer will be the most luxurious ship in the world. It's a bold statement, but I have to say that what I've seen and heard so far is impressive. Silversea is far more modest. Silver Muse will simply 'raise the bar in the ultra-luxury market'. You'll have to wait a bit longer to find out what that means!

After a spell of investment in the expedition sector, Silversea have finally announced an order with Italian shipbuilder Fincantieri for another all-suite luxury ship. Their classic European approach offers a stylish yet casual experience which is proving a real winner! (See pages 47-49 to sample Silversea's all-inclusive value).

The Carnival group of companies have placed the largest ever newbuilding contract, with letters of intent for at

least nine more ships to be delivered up to 2020; the business split between Fincantieri and Germany's Meyer yards. Clever planning allows Carnival to order a series of standard designs, and then tailor each to a specific brand (Carnival, Princess, Holland America, Costa, P&O or Cunard) closer to the delivery date.

This approach has certainly benefited P&O and Cunard here in the UK, with both lines introducing super new ships recently. (See pages 22-23 for our latest P&O Cruises promotion).

Mentioning Meyer yards reminds me that they too have joined the modern trend to expansion and globalisation by taking over the Finnish shipyards which build the very biggest of all cruise ships for Royal Caribbean.

When I first joined this industry the Spanish still built passenger ships, including three for the Norwegian owned, and now defunct, Crown Cruise Line. The first was Crown Monarch, a really pretty little ship of

which a builder's model still graces my study! I sailed on her inaugural voyage from Palm Beach, Florida, waving goodbye on the chic French Caribbean island of St. Barthelemy. After some changes of ownership, she has been beautifully refitted to sail as Voyager for Voyages of Discovery as we've noted before, it's a

> pleasure to still have these smaller ship experiences on offer. (See pages 12-15 for our brand new Voyages of Discovery promotion).

Our own holiday travels this year are more land-based

since the Indian Ocean voyage with Balmoral in February, but plans for 2016 are of course in hand, and could see us in South America next March...

Char Siu Bao Barbecue pork-filled bun

FOOD FOR THOUGHT: CHAR SIU BAO BARBECUE PORK-FILLED BUN

MAKES - 8 SERVES - 4

INGREDIENTS FOR THE CHAR SIU

- 30g honey
- · 2 tbs Shaoxing rice wine
- 100ml hoi sin sauce
- 1 tbs soy sauce
- 3 heaped tbs yellow bean sauce
- 600g pork fillet

FOR THE BUN DOUGH

- · 250ml warm water
- · 7g dried yeast
- 2 tbs sugar
- 1½ tsp baking powder
- Pinch of salt
- 450g plain flour

TO SERVE

· Sweet chilli sauce

METHOD

- For the char siu, put the honey, rice wine, hoi sin, soy and yellow bean sauces in a food bag. Add the meat, rub the marinade in well, then seal the bag and refrigerate overnight.
- The next day preheat the oven to 200°C/gas mark
 Put about 2cm of water in the bottom of a roasting tray. Put a rack on top and sit the meat on it. Roast for 25 minutes, brushing on more marinade and turning every now and again. Allow to rest for 10 minutes and set the remaining marinade aside.
- For the dough, mix the water, yeast, sugar, baking powder and salt, and whisk for 3-4 minutes until foaming.
- 4. Put the flour in a large bowl and make a well in the centre. Add the liquid to the flour, mix until it comes together then knead until it forms a smooth dough. Cover and leave to prove for 1 hour.
- 5. Tip the dough onto a floured surface and knead again for 5 minutes. Divide into 8 pieces then roll each piece into an 8cm disc.



- Finely chop the char siu and mix with the remaining marinade. Place a tablespoon of the mixture in the middle of each disc then wrap the dough up around the meat and seal with a pinch.
- Place the buns sealed-side down on a piece of parchment in a steamer. Make a cross on top with a knife, cover and steam for 10 minutes.
- 8. Serve immediately with sweet chilli sauce.
