America

Stateside, with the USA home to nearly 3,000 commercial vineyards,

wine production is a mass operation.

California's Napa Valley flourishes with both red and white grapes, and the warm days and cooler nights provide the perfect incubator for Cabernet Sauvignons and Chardonnay.

Argentinian and Chilean grapes have gained precedence in recent years, with global consumers savouring 15 hectolitres of the two regions' reserves combined. Malbec, native to France's Bordeaux, has jumped ship with Argentina now producing the lion's share worldwide.

Antarctica

The desolate ice lands of the Antarctic may not be the first choice

for aficionados, but those in the know will recognise its efforts toward the white grape wine Riesling. Vastly more superior, perhaps, are its Seyval and Vidal Blanc offerings – both of which perform better in the high salt content found in Antarctica's soil.

The McMurdo Dry Valleys give the wines a subtle salty yet sweet aftertaste, and Antarctica's intrepid producers have teamed up with local wildlife to ensure their vines get the nutrients they need, relying on penguins to provide fertiliser.

Asia

Wines from the Far East are improving. Today, China is the

fifth largest wine producer in the world and what it lacks in heritage it certainly makes up for in appreciation, with the country being the second biggest consumer of high-priced labels globally.

In India, principal grape cultivation happens in the vibrant states of Maharashtra, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh, where sophisticated sippers prefer the country's sparkling wines.

Australasia

Australia is beloved for its fruity wines at the affordable end of the scale, but

that's not to say the industry isn't sporting a few elegant labels. The varying climate in Australia makes this territory capable of catering to a wide range of budgets and palates.

Blending experience with contemporary enthusiasm, New Zealand wines simultaneously recount the story of the past and today's new approach to exceptional wine making.

This is especially clear at the Ascension Winery, situated on iron-rich terrain outside of Auckland. The family's passion is exemplified in 'The Bell Ringer' Pinotage, a supple red fragrance with peppery notes and juicy blueberries that offers a kiwi twist to a South African idea.

Europe

Undoubtedly a stalwart in the industry, French wine has graced tables across the world since the 6th century

BC. Most of us will be familiar with Burgundy, Bordeaux, Champagne and Rhône, just a few of the prestigious provinces establishing the country's claim to the art of wine.

Switzerland's rich history of wine is a secret to many, with only 1.5 per cent of Swiss wine being exported. For those looking to unearth the alpine country's treasures, Fendant is the Swiss name for the refreshing, dry white Chasselas that is the après ski drink of choice.

EASTER ISLAND

Just south of the Tropic of Capricorn, Easter Island, or Rapa Nui, lies 3,790km to the west of Chile. Extraordinarily remote, this island was first inhabited by Polynesians who are believed to have arrived by sea about 1,200 years ago. The island is 24km long, with three extinct volcanic craters and half of the area is a National Park. The island is best known for being the site of more than 600 stone statues, or Moai, which stand up to nine metres in height. The statues were carved in the spectacular Rano Raraku quarry and were then believed to have been transported on wooden rollers to their destinations. It is thought that the last statues were erected around 500 years ago, when the supply of trees for rollers ran out.

A CASE OF **DÉJÀ VU**

At last the wait is over. It has taken a long time but Norwegian Cruise Line is finally basing a ship in Southampton again from next year. Not just that, but she is the same ship as when the company last sailed from the UK – Norwegian Jade – although by the time she gets here she'll be looking quite different from when I last saw her.

That was in May 2008, as she was about to set sail on her maiden cruise from Southampton. An article I wrote back then noted Jade had been relocated to the UK from Hawaii, where she had sailed as Pride of Hawaii. It said there were around 1.500 British passengers booked on each sailing and there was British beer to keep them happy.

I gather the British beer will be back when Jade returns in 2017, but the jury's out on whether they'll have kettles in cabins. Might be a good idea. After all, the Brits do like their morning cuppa!

A couple of NCL's newer features have already made their way onto Jade. There is a Moderno Churrascaria and Carlo's Bake Shop selling cakes. However there will be a major refurbishment in March 2017, just before she arrives in the UK two months later. Among changes, teak flooring will be laid in the outdoor deck areas, the Bliss nightclub will be revamped, and new carpets, curtains and furniture will be installed.

NCL's decision to return to no-fly cruising is welcome news. Competition is always healthy, and it means that come 2017, those who like the company's Freestyle philosophy (no dress codes, no formal dining) can enjoy casual cruising without having to fly.

NCL is keeping Jade close to home -a couple of mini-cruises to Hamburg, a few seven night romps around the cities of Hamburg, Amsterdam, Zeebrugge and Le Havre and nine night voyages to the Norwegian fjords. It makes sense. NCL will have three ships in the Mediterranean next year for those wanting a casual cruise in the sun.

GETAWAY TO THE BALTIC

Just as Norwegian Jade is arriving in Southampton, one of Norwegian Cruise Line's newest and biggest ships will be settling into her new homeport in Copenhagen.

Norwegian Getaway, launched in January 2014, holds just under 4,000 passengers and will be taking over NCL's Baltic cruise itinerary from May 2017.

She boasts some attractive amenities, including Studio cabins for solo travellers, posh suites in the exclusive Haven and if you've always wanted to clamber over a ropes course or slide down a flume while sailing into St. Petersburg, well now's your chance.

Getaway will be sailing nine-night cruises from Copenhagen that visit Tallinn, Helsinki and Stockholm, and spend two days in St. Petersburg. There is also a day in Warnemünde in Germany, a seaside resort used for excursions to Berlin.

It is do-able but it's a long journey to the



city and you don't get much time there. My tip is to go instead to Rostock, a former Hanseatic town just 30 minutes from the port. It was once in East Germany, where among other attractions (an ancient astronomical clock, good beer) you can visit a former Stasi prison. If you were as gripped as me by the TV series Deutschland 83 that was shown earlier this year, about East and West Berlin during the Cold War, it's a must.





IS AMERICA'S FLAGSHIP TO SAIL AGAIN?

One piece of cruise news that has got everyone talking is Crystal Cruises' plan to restore the liner SS United States to her former glory, once more plying transatlantic routes to and from New York.

"It will be a challenging undertaking," said Edie Rodrigues, Crystal's president and CEO, in what must be the understatement of the year. The ship launched in 1952 so is more than 60 years behind the times when it comes to modern shipbuilding practices. Equally, ships deteriorate very quickly when they sit idle and she has been inactive since being retired in 1969.

Part of a top-secret Pentagon programme, the SS United States was designed to convert from a luxury liner into a naval troopship if the Cold War ever turned hot. Thankfully it didn't, so instead of servicemen she hosted four US presidents, Monaco's Prince Rainier and Grace Kelly, and Hollywood stars including John Wayne, Marilyn Monroe and Marlon Brando. In 1952

she set a record for the fastest transatlantic crossing, which has never been broken.

If the restoration happens (and it is an if, because a feasibility study has to be carried out before the project goes ahead) it will cost between \$700 million and \$800 million – an eye-watering sum but a drop in the ocean, so to speak, given Crystal's other expansion plans.

The company launched a 62-passenger yacht at the end of last year, has three 1,000-passenger ships on order, bought two aircraft to offer luxury air holidays around the world and is about to enter the river cruise sector. It acquired a river boat, Mozart, which will be refurbished and launched in July, and is building another four due to enter service in 2017.

And just to make sure all goes according to plan, Crystal's parent company, Genting Hong Kong, bought the Lloyd Werft shipyard in Bremerhaven, Germany, where all the new ships will be built as well!

Apart from a handful of luxury ships, all the orders are for ever-larger capacity, ranging from 2,500 to 5,500 lower beds with an increasing range of dining options and innovative entertainment concepts.

I recently visited the Meyer Werft shipyard in Papenburg, northern Germany, and was able to see their remarkable "block construction" system whereby the ships appear to be assembled like a giant Lego kit! The yard is working at full capacity delivering two ships a year, and any operator now wishing to place an order will have to wait until at least 2022 for delivery!

The commitment to all these new projects is driven by the increasing

globalisation of the cruise business. Although the North American market is still dominant, with Western Europe steadily catching up, the new growth is in the Far East. We are now seeing ships designed specifically

for oriental tastes and culture, so for example Princess Royal Caribbean, Celebrity and Norwegian Cruises all have ships planned to be based in China, whilst Costa are introducing a "Costa Asia" brand for regional use. Even the Australian market has grown to the

point where P&O Australia will build a dedicated new ship for 2019 delivery.

Doubtless in due course China will start to build its own cruise ships, but at the moment all the skills required are only found in a few European shipyards.

Ship design concepts are somewhat constrained by the likely disposition, as a hull fit for world-wide voyages needs to be quite different to the

relatively simple shallow version which will suffice in the Caribbean. Similarly, ideas such the MSC Seaside promenade deck at a level quite close to the waterline is definitely set to be based in calm tropical waters!

For the UK, one spin-off from this expansion is that fleets will have more vessels to move around the world, so both Norwegian and MSC have announced their intention to bring ships back into the UK for at least summer seasons, probably as soon as 2017.

This is an industry where it is sometimes quite difficult to remember today's date, when planning is always running at least three years ahead, and 2018 itineraries are on sale for many ships!



In 1775, the people of New England began fighting the British for their independence and on 2nd July 1776, the Congress secretly voted for independence from Great Britain. The Declaration of Independence was first published two days later on 4th July, 1776, but wasn't actually signed until a month later.

The first deception of how Independence Day would be celebrated was in a letter from John Adams to his wife Abigail on 3rd July 1776. He described "pomp and parade. with shows, games, sports, guns, bells, bonfires and illuminations" throughout the United States. However, the term "Independence Day" was not used until 1791. Commonly known as the Fourth of July, today Independence Day is a federal holiday in the United States where celebrations include fireworks, parades, barbecues, carnivals, sports games and much more. Interestingly, Thomas Jefferson and John Adams, both signers of the Declaration of Independence and presidents of the United States, died on 4th July 1826 - exactly 50 years after the adoption of the declaration.







Hot Cross Buns



PREP TIME - OVER 2 HRS
COOK TIME - 10 - 30 MINS
MAKES 12 BUNS

INGREDIENTS

- 625g strong white flour
- 1 tsp salt
- · 2 tsp ground mixed spice
- 45g unsalted butter, cubed, plus extra for greasing
- 85g sugar
- · 1 lemon, zest only
- 1½ tsp fast-acting yeast
- 1 free-range egg
- 275ml tepid milk
- · 125g mixed dried fruit

TOPPING

- 2 tbsp plain flour
- · Vegetable oil for greasing
- 1 tbsp golden syrup, gently heated for glazing

METHOD

- To make the buns, sieve the flour, salt and ground mixed spice into a large mixing bowl; rub in the butter. Form a well in the centre and add the sugar, lemon zest and yeast.
- 2. Add the beaten egg and the tepid milk. Mix to a soft, pliable dough.
- Place the dough onto a lightly floured work surface and work in the dried fruit. Knead gently for 5 mins, or until smooth and elastic.
- Grease a large, warm mixing bowl with butter and add the dough ball, cover with a tea towel and leave in a warm place for one hour to prove.
- Roll the proved dough onto a lightly floured work surface and knead the dough. Reshape into a ball and return to the bowl, re-cover and set aside for a further 30 mins.
- Divide the dough into 12 equal pieces. Roll each piece into a ball, then flatten slightly into a bun. Cover the buns with the tea towel and set aside for 5-10 mins.
- 7. Grease a baking tray with butter then



add the buns. Wrap the tray loosely in greaseproof paper and place inside a large polythene bag. Tie the end of the bag and set aside in a warm place for a further 40 mins to rise.

- 8. Preheat the oven to 240C/475F/Gas 8.
- For the topping, mix the plain flour to a smooth paste with 2 tbsp of cold water.
- 10. When the buns have risen, remove the polythene bag and greaseproof paper. Spoon the topping mixture into a piping bag and pipe a cross on to each hun.
- 11. Bake the buns for 8-12 mins, or until pale golden-brown. Remove the buns from the oven, immediately brush with the hot golden syrup and place on a wire rack to cool.
