The world's most stunning architecture

from some of its most unusual locations

Architecture is something that many of us give little thought to. The buildings that we encounter on a day-to-day basis are so familiar to us that we hardly notice the design and engineering prowess that goes into creating such a structure.

Occasionally though, we may come across a building that is so stunningly intricate, so majestic and so historically rich that we can do little but marvel at it. So here are three unexpected locations that are often touted as pillars of architectural calibre.



MYANMAR (BURMA)


Architecture in its many forms goes back to around the year 800 in Myanmar, with the Bagan Empire. The country's most notable features are the Buddhist temples and pagodas, often called zedis, payas or stupas. The Shwedagon Pagoda is perhaps the most stunning of them all, standing as a giant golden monument to Buddhism. Monasteries and royal palaces constructed with teak wood of the colonial era can also be found, although many imperial structures are now left to become part of the undergrowth, such as those in the city of Yangon.

BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA


Buenos Aires' architecture is situated at the crossroads of its 'Old World' history and its fiercely independent present-day culture. Art Nouveau apartments sit alongside Renaissance-style palaces, adapting European aesthetics to create original Argentinian styles. Avenida de Mayo features a grand stretch of buildings, including the Palacio del Congreso and the decaying Confiteria El Molino. The Palacio Barolo is similarly impressive – a neo-Gothic tribute to Dante's Divine Comedy that rises 100m above the streets and has 22 floors, symbolising the masterpiece's 100 songs with 22 verses each. Any art-lover must also see the Floralis Generica, a solar-powered flower sculpture designed by Eduardo Catalano with awe-inspiring giant metallic petals that open to the sun.

PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC

Prague is the largest urban historical centre on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Romanesque buildings with groin vaults such as the Basilica of St. George sit alongside gothic structures like St. Vitus Cathedral, with its pointed arches and flying buttresses. Belvedere is a prime example of Renaissance architecture, with bohemian-style stucco décor and paintings of mythical scenes. You can also spot the lavish styles of Baroque buildings, such as the Church of St. Nicholas, a fine example of the chiaroscuro effect. More modern styles include the Art Nouveau Palace of Industry and Cubist apartments. One sight not to miss is The Dancing House on Rasinovo Quay, which looks almost like a figure shaking its hips to the music of this lively city.





reckon every country has its own sound. Think about it. Car horns in New York, even more car horns in India, oompah bands in Germany, Mozart and Strauss in Austria. After a cruise on the Ayeyarwady in Myanmar this summer, I've concluded its sound is industry.

Thud thud. That was women bashing clay pots in the village of Yandabo. Bang, bang. Men hammering pieces of gold until they are thinner than paper. Ker-plunk, ker-plunk. Young girls weaving on ancient wooden looms in a factory in Mandalay.

I was sailing on the 72 passenger Princess Panhwar, a new vessel that has been a sellout success since being launched this year by APT's 4★ Travelmarvel brand (but don't worry - Reader Offers not only has several departure dates from September 2017 onwards but great prices as well).

It's not difficult to see why she has been in demand. This is a beautiful vessel with polished teak decks (your shoes are cleaned by the lovely crew every time you return from a shore excursion to help protect the wood) and spacious cabins. Mine was a deluxe suite with a small balcony, a bug screen to keep flying beasties out and a spacious bathroom with shower.

And then there is the itinerary – a 14 night cruise between Yangon and Mandalay that shows off so much of what Myanmar has to offer while avoiding too much travelling on the bumpy roads that are a legacy of all the years the country was ruled by a military dictatorship.

Incidentally you also avoid a lesson in Burmese driving skills, which our guide, Zaw, explained were "based on the principles of flexibility and mutual understanding rather than rules". And he wasn't joking!

There's the gleaming Shwedagon Pagoda in Yangon, 328 feet high and covered in 11 tons of gold, and tours of villages, markets and Minhla fort, which was built to fend off the British. It failed to do that. In 1885, after the Third Anglo-Burmese War, Burma became a province of British India and was finally given independence in 1948.

At Akauk Taung, look out for the thousands of Buddha images carved in the cliff by boatmen who had to stop here to pay tolls after the Second Anglo-Burmese War. At Pyay, a tour visits the golden Shwesandaw Pagoda that is said to contain two of Buddha's hairs. All the tours are complimentary, and Travelmarvel also includes wine, beer or soft drinks with lunch and dinner, as much bottled water as you can drink and all tips in the price.

Reader Offers sells this cruise from south to north, which is the perfect way to do it as there is plenty of sailing time at the start so you can relax and get over any jetlag before arriving in Bagan, a city famous for its thousands of temples, pagodas and stupas. And in a country where every town and village has temples, pagodas and stupas that is no mean feat.

There used to be more than 5,000 but many were destroyed in earthquakes so now there are just 2,237. Happily Travelmarvel's guides don't feel the need to take you every one but they visit a few of the best, including the fine Ananda Temple. And you will get a chance to watch the sun set over the Bagan Plain, which is truly delightful.

In Yandabo we watched women thud those clay pots into shape – each makes around 4,000 a month and they are fired in a 'kiln', which is more like a huge funeral pyre - and the village children put on a little show that included a local rendition of Frère Jacques (and we sang the French version for them!). If you have brought colouring pens or books from the UK, give them to their teacher to distribute rather than directly to the children so they don't get in the habit of begging.

As we sailed, the three local guides travelling with us gave lectures on the history and culture of Myanmar, as well as lessons in how to wear a longyi, the traditional costume, and thanaka, a white paste made from tree bark that women use as make-up and to protect their skin from the sun.

In Inwa, horse-drawn carriages were waiting to take us to see the local 'leaning tower' and two beautiful teak monasteries. They should have been the highlight of the day, but Rambo, the horse pulling my carriage, stole the show. He put his ears back and set off at breakneck speed, cutting corners, overtaking




slower steeds and reluctantly stopping at the designated sights while my friend and I did our best to avoid bouncing out the back. Great fun!

By now the days were super busy – the 13th century Ponya Pagoda, where I watched in awe as workers scaled bamboo scaffolding high above the ground without safety harnesses, the 17th century egg-shaped Kaungmudaw Pagoda, the unfinished pagoda in Mingun that would have been a towering 150 metres high except that King Bodawpaya, who ordered it to be built, was warned he would die if it was ever finished. Needless to say, it was never finished but he still died.

In Mandalay, we saw the world's biggest book according to the Guinness Book of Records – 729 marble slabs inscribed by Buddhist teachings – in Kuthadaw Pagoda and a statue of Buddha in Maha Muni

Pagoda that is getting bigger because so much gold leaf has been added to it over the years by praying men (women aren't allowed to go near it).

We also watched the gold beaters in action (such strenuous work they have to take a break every three minutes), visited silk and wood-carving factories and rounded off the day in a gondola on the calm waters of

BREAD & BUTTER PUDDIN

WITH WHITE CHOCOLATE AND CRANBERRIES



INGREDIENTS

CUSTARD

- 4 eggs
- 6 egg yolks
- 80g caster sugar
- 500ml whole milk
- 500ml double cream

BREAD AND BUTTER PUDDING

- 10 slices of stale white bread
- 150g butter, softened
- 2 tsp ground mixed spice
- 150g cranberries, semi-dried
- 200g white chocolate buttons
- 2 tbsp Demerara sugar

SATSUMA AND CRANBERRY SUZETTE

- 6 satsumas
- 75g cranberries, semi-dried
- 200g caster sugar
- 100g butter
- 200ml fresh orange juice

METHOD

- 1. Prepare the custard. Beat the eggs and sugar together in a bowl. Add the milk and cream to a pan, bring to a simmer and remove from the heat; pour into the eggs and sugar and mix
- 2. Butter an ovenproof dish. Remove the crusts from the sliced bread and butter all of the slices on one side. Halve the slices
- 3. Cover the bottom of the dish with a layer of buttered bread. Sprinkle with mixed spice, some cranberries and some of the white chocolate
- 4. Cover the first layer with a little custard. Repeat this process to make more layers of bread then custard (leave a little custard for serving). Press down firmly, cover with cling film and leave in the fridge overnight

- 5. Prepare the suzette. Segment the satsumas. Add the sugar to a nonstick pan and heat until a golden caramel forms. Remove from the heat and add the butter
- 6. Mix in the butter by shaking the pan, add the orange juice and return to the heat. Bring to the boil and reduce until it reaches the consistency of a caramel. Stir in the cranberries and satsuma
- segments and warm through Preheat the oven to 160°C/gas
- 8. Remove the cling film from the bread and butter pudding and sprinkle some Demerara sugar over the top. Bake for 30-40 minutes
- 9. Spoon some warm suzette over the pudding. Serve with custard
