Cruise Miles Ambassador Jennie Bond shares her experience of cruising the River Rhine with Uniworld

or some years now, my husband has had a quirky obsession with a car ferry across the Rhine at a picturesque little German town called Linz. It's part of his morning ritual to watch the webcam from the comfort of our home in Devon and tell me how the ferry service is faring. He shares this curious hobby with a friend in the village, and they often imagine themselves sitting by the river, having a drink at the hotel they can see on the webcam.

And that is really how we came to be cruising down the Rhine from Breisach to Amsterdam, via Linz, on a luxurious river boat which proved to be a floating five star hotel.

Now Jim and I are veteran ocean cruisers, but a river cruise was something entirely new for both of us.

Heidelberg, Germany

Our first impressions of Uniworld's SS Antoinette were favourable, to say the least. The ship is far longer and larger than I'd expected, with huge tinted windows through which guests are treated to a panoramic view of the passing scenery – but no-one can see in.

I was immediately struck by how grand everything looked: the lobby is dominated by a vivid blue chandelier which once graced a classy New York restaurant. White marble gives a sense of opulence, and the furnishings are all softness and satin with more than a hint of Louis XVI. In fact, the name of the ship has nothing to do with Marie-Antoinette, but there is definitely a regal air to the decor.

"What we aim for," says Michael Teller, the Hotel Manager, "is to make all our ships feel different – from one other and from every other cruise ship."

Our stateroom – Category 2 – was a very reasonable size with a big, comfy bed, one chair and plenty of wardrobe and drawer space. The large picture window slides down electronically so that you can stand, leaning on the banister, looking out at the world. It's classed as a French balcony and we spent most of the cruise with it fully open.

SS Antoinette can house 150 guests and carries 65 crew. And that's a ratio which allows the crew to get to know you – and your tastes – very quickly. I was rather embarrassed when, by the third day, the bar staff reached for the Sauvignon Blanc as soon as they saw me. But I soon discovered that they knew everyone's favourite tipple by then! And having everything included – food, unlimited drinks and all the excursions – made life delightfully uncomplicated.

The excursions were certainly worthwhile. One of our favourites was

to a wine vinegar estate in Venningen which was both beautiful and a revelation. Never before had we been invited to a "vinegar tasting". First, though, we were asked to don monk-like cloaks to protect the purity of the great casks of fine vinegar, as we inspected them by candlelight in the dark cellars. Having learned about the history and production of these special vinegars, we tasted four or five – just a sip or two in long-stemmed shot glasses. I'd never considered vinegar as an aperitif or digestif – but these were different, with wonderful names and tastes. We ended up buying three bottles; in fact I've just had a sip of "You Are My Heart's Delight" whilst writing this!

Every day brought us to a new destination – with a new cultural experience on offer. I loved the fact that we straddled the border between Germany and France: the visit to Colmar – sometimes described as the most beautiful town in the world – was a delight and gave me a brief opportunity to brush up on my French.

Back in Germany, Heidelberg was fascinating and our guide, Sonia (who, by her own admission, resembled Mary Poppins) entertained us with all sorts of anecdotes and historical facts on a two hour walking tour. Wine-tasting at a 14th century castle near Rudesheim was another

winner, but we foolishly missed out on a tour of the music museum in the town itself. Our fellow guests raved about it!

On board again, we had the most wonderful afternoon drifting past the historic Castles that are so liberally dotted along this stretch of the river. The sun was scorching, the drinks flowed and the scenery was stunning.

Even on a rainy day, *SS Antoinette* gave us plenty to do. I went swimming in the small but adequate indoor pool. There's a jet stream to swim against if you're feeling energetic and big windows that open to give you a great view of the river while you're in the pool. There's also a spa, a gym, and a cinema.

We'd never been to Germany before and we were both impressed by the friendliness we found everywhere, the music that rings out from so many street corners and squares, the culture and history of a country that, for many of us, has always been associated with the horrors of war.

And – of course – I mustn't forget the ferry at Linz. We approached it as dusk gathered on a cool, breezy evening. Even I got quite excited at the prospect of seeing the little boat and the pub for real. Suddenly, there it was: a small car ferry crossing the Rhine on one of its dozens of daily journeys. And, on the river bank, the hotel with lights twinkling and seats waiting on the balcony for my husband and his friend. And then it was gone.

Ah well! One day – we shall return, and linger.

left you last month with a taste of some of the most extravagant features on *Seven Seas Explorer®*, the new Regent Seven Seas Cruises® ship that the company dubbed the most luxurious ever built – even before she was built!

It's a bold claim, and also a tricky one because everyone has their own idea of what luxury means. So who better than Frank Del Rio, the boss of Norwegian Cruise Line Holdings, which owns Regent, to explain what made his new baby the most luxurious ship. His answer? Timeless. I will be a bit more verbose and say if a small all-suite ship, personal service, gourmet dining and the luxury of almost everything included in the price does it for you, then you will love this ship.

Sounds like any other Regent ship? Maybe, but it really isn't. From the headline-grabbing Regent Suite at the front of the ship (4,443 square foot of living space and an eye-watering \$10,000 a night price tag) to a cookery school where you can learn a few tricks of the culinary trade, this ship is something very new and very special.

Sadly I wasn't in the Regent Suite, but my Concierge Suite was fine by me. It had a

large balcony, bathroom and walk-in wardrobe, and my bed faced the window so I woke to sea views. Actually if I was going to trade up, it would be to one of the Master Suites at the back of the ship. They might not be as big as the Regent Suite, and they don't have their own spa, but they do have huge wrap-around balconies that are perfect for private outdoor living. The Prime 7 steakhouse is the only speciality restaurant on Explorer that features on Regent's other ships. Chartreuse is a new Parisian-styled bistro serving cheese soufflé, steak tartar, snails, foie gras, rack of lamb, duck and other French favourites.

I had a great meal there but my favourite was Pacific Rim, which serves authentic Asian dishes such as spring rolls, duck and watermelon salad, Vietnamese beef soup and mouth-watering curries.

And I must give a special mention to the Pool Grill, which has the best bratwurst sausages I've had outside Germany – spicy, cooked to order and served with fries, they were yummy!

As on all Regent ships, the speciality dining is included in the fare, as are flights, transfers, drinks, gratuities, Wi-Fi and many shore excursions. In fact one of the only things you do have to pay extra for are lessons in the cookery school,

There is one more thing about Explorer that makes her stand out – not just from other Regent ships, but every other luxury vessel – and that's the décor. It's opulent, elegant and wonderfully ostentatious, with no expense spared.

There is enough marble to cover an American football field, 473 crystal chandeliers, leather flooring in the library, gold leaf finish on the ceilings and exotic woods in the suites. The artwork alone cost \$6 million and includes the prayer wheel I mentioned last month. Cast in bronze and the weight of a car, it stands at the entrance to the Pacific Rim restaurant to get you in the mood for the Asian food

I loved the yellow-and-gold colour scheme

Del Rio promised a sister ship to Explorer, launching in 2020 will be even more luxurious. There's nothing like setting yourself a challenge!

THE CRUISE INDUSTRY IS HAVING TO TAKE QUITE A FLEXIBLE APPROACH TO FORWARD PLANNING THESE DAYS, WITH A VARIETY OF FACTORS CONSPIRING TO MAKE THE FUTURE RATHER UNCERTAIN.

With an all-time record number of ships on order (over 80 for delivery up to 2023!), the major operators must be sincerely grateful that the growth in Chinese passenger numbers is exceeding previous forecasts. This is allowing more of the new-builds to be tailored to oriental requirements and deployed to Asian home ports.

Troubles in Turkey and the ongoing migrant situation have discouraged the ever-cautious Americans from visiting the Eastern Mediterranean, so the ships based there are tending to be moved away. Some are now seeing in North European waters instead, giving us an ever wider choice of ships and itineraries within easy access. Another area seeing more capacity is the Caribbean, which is still seen by the Americans as their own backyard, and therefore a safe holiday choice. With such a large number of

islands, more newly developed ports and the cruise lines' own private resorts, the Caribbean does look set to build even further on its number one position as top cruise destination. (See pages 22 & 23 -P&O Caribbean).

RED VELVET CAKE

CAKE INGREDIENTS

- 250 g (9oz) unsalted butter, softened
- 250 g (9oz) caster sugar
- ½ tsp red food colouring
- 2 tsp vanilla extract
- 3 large eggs
- 284 ml tub buttermilk
- 2 tsp cider vinegar
- 275 g (10oz) self-raising flour
- 1 tsp bicarbonate of soda
- 40 g (1¹/₂oz) cocoa powder

ICING INGREDIENTS

- 275 g (10oz) unsalted butter, softened
- 400 g (14oz) full-fat cream cheese at room temperature
- 475 g (1lb 1oz) icing sugar
- Coloured sugar sprinkles, optional
- Coloured sugar sprinkles, optional

METHOD

- Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C fan), gas mark 4. Grease a deep, round 20.5cm (8in) cake tin and line with baking parchment.
- In a mixer, or using an electric whisk, beat together the butter and sugar until pale and fluffy then blend in the red food colouring.
- 3. In a large container beat together the eggs, buttermilk, vanilla and cider vinegar. Add the red butter mixture and beat until combined (the mixture may look a little curdled). Sieve over the flour, bicarbonate of soda and cocoa powder and fold together using a large spatula.
- 4. Transfer to the prepared cake tin, level off and then bake for 55-60 minutes (poke a skewer into the centre, if it comes out clean the cake is ready). Leave to cool in tin for 10 minutes, then transfer to a wire cooling rack until completely cool.
- While the cake is cooling beat the butter in a mixer or with an electric whisk until completely smooth. Then beat in the cream cheese. Sieve over the

icing sugar and beat gently until fluffy.

 Carefully cut cooled cake into three layers. Sandwich the layers together with some of the icing, then ice the top and sides of the cake. Decorate with sugar sprinkles, slice and enjoy!
