ever more ships are sailing from UK ports, including chic European line Silversea (see pages 42 & 43).

Another hot topic of conversation in the States was the opening up of travel possibilities to Cuba as diplomatic ties with the US are improving. The more sophisticated travellers are, like ourselves, concerned that the destination will ultimately be swamped

by down-market catering brands once American capital investment is allowed, so we tend to hope for slow progress!

Right now Cuba's infrastructure is somewhere in the 50s, which gives it a certain faded charm as long as visitor numbers are limited and expectations not too high. We really enjoyed our

visits to Havana and some provincial ports during the time when Fred. Olsen were developing itineraries which first included Cuba, and then sought to base programmes there. This was so significant that negotiations went

> right up to the Castro brothers' level. Facilities were frankly quite daunting, with airlines reluctant to operate there and port services very limited.

> For those who enjoy exotic destinations with a laid-back feel, I can heartily recommend giving Cuba a try while it is still so unspoilt (join *Columbus* on page 12).

> We finished our brief NY State visit with a dinner on a terrace overlooking the Hudson

River – all in agreement that there is a fascination about boats and ships which keeps luring us back!

PORT OUT - AND BACK AS WELL!

Forget the spruced up King's Court, allnew Carinthia Lounge and those single cabins. Want to know the best new feature on Cunard's *Queen Mary 2* following her multi-million-dollar makeover? The port wall.

I confess I was a little underwhelmed when told there is a port wall. A wall on the left? It didn't sound very exciting. Turns out it was not a port wall, but a wall of port. You know, the fortified stuff from Portugal, invented incidentally in the late 1600s to stop wine from spoiling when



being exported to England.

Even if you don't like port, you can't help but get excited about this. Anthony Habert, Carnival UK's head of beverage services and a walking encyclopedia on all things tipple, has managed to secure 46 port vintages produced in momentous years starting with 1840 (when Cunard launched).

There's some from 1851, the date London hosted the Great Exhibition and 1863, when President Abraham Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation freeing

the slaves in the US. A 1934 Ferreira was produced the year Cunard launched the original *Queen Mary* and Hitler came to power in Germany. The list goes on and on.

The 1840s bottles are so rare there are only 30-40 left in the world. If you want to buy one, it will set you back a mere \$4,450. Hmm. Much cheaper to book one of the port flights, where a sommelier will guide you through tasting four varieties. There are three flights, with prices from \$10.95.

If port isn't your tipple, how about chocolate? Sir Samuel's is now a coffee shop selling seriously over-the-top Belgian Godiva chocolate. I indulged in a cone full of chocolate ice cream, dipped croissant pieces in chocolate fondue and tried a few milk chocolates. Naughty? You bet. But so nice!

I was on QM2 for eight nights, sailing from Southampton to New York on her first voyage after the refit so there was plenty of time to see the changes.

Cunard called it 'remastering', which is very American but does give you a sense that this was more than a mid-life facelift. Indeed, over the course of 25 days £90 million was lavished on the ship. Furniture and furnishings have been renewed (there's enough new carpet to cover 10 football pitches) and there were some major changes to the hardware.

The glass elevators have gone from the atrium, making that space larger and less



cluttered, and 15 single cabins have been added. I managed to peek into one and was impressed. No balcony, but it had two large round windows that let in plenty of light, a small double bed (somewhere between a single and standard double) and a walk-in glass-fronted shower.

I was in a swanky Princess Grills Suite with a balcony and walk-in wardrobe, but you had to climb into the bath to have a shower and both were adorned with a drab shower curtain. Hopefully that will change in the next refit.

The Winter Garden has become the tasteful Carinthia Lounge and by day two of the voyage was established as a favourite place for morning coffee and light bites at lunchtime. In the King's Court self-service, there are now separate serving stations, at a stroke banishing queues.

As before, a section of the King's Court becomes a waiter-service speciality restaurant in the evenings. However, alongside the Italian, Indian, Asian and Mexican eateries that previously popped up on selected evenings, there is a Smokehouse restaurant. It's American BBQ food, full of taste and a bargain at \$15 per person. The Verandah Restaurant that has replaced Todd English is posher but also great value at \$35 per person. The menu is French with leisurely Gallic-style service to match so if you like to see the shows, start eating early!

Happily some things have not changed. I saw two shows in the Planetarium, attended lectures on the history of liner travel, cruising and New York's iconic skyscrapers by self-confessed ship nut Bill Miller and a behind-the-scenes look at the events on the night of the Brighton bombing in 1984 by Barry Cave, one of the detectives called to the Grand Hotel after the blast.

I went to a line-dancing class, tried Thai reflexology treatment in the Canyon Ranch Spa and sweated in the sauna and steam room in the thermal suite. And of course I drank port. Not the 1840 bottle, you understand, but I tasted my way through two flights. That's eight varieties.

So decadent, but then as Bill explained in his excellent talks, that's what transatlantic travel is all about!

A SNEAK PEEK

Hard on the heels of my transatlantic crossing, I was lucky enough to spend five nights on the most luxurious ship ever built, Regent Seven Seas Cruises' new Seven Seas Explorer®.

Does she live up to the billing? You'll have to wait for my report in next month's Blue Horizons but to whet your appetite, I must mention the leather flooring in the library, the stunning hand-made chandeliers and an imitation Tibetan prayer wheel that weighs as much as a car...!

CHORIZO PILAF



PREP TIME – 10 MINS COOK TIME – 40 MINS SERVES 4

INGREDIENTS

- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 large onion, thinly sliced
- 250g chorizo, sliced
- · 4 garlic cloves, crushed
- 1 tsp smoked paprika
- 400g chopped tomatoes
- 250g basmati rice, rinsed
- 600ml chicken stock
- Black pepper, freshly ground
- 1 lemon, preferably unwaxed, zest thickly grated, plus wedges to serve
- 2 bay leaves, fresh
- Handful of fresh parsley, chopped



METHOD

- In a large pan heat the oil. Add the onion and fry for 5-8 minutes until soft and golden. Move to the edge of the pan and add the chorizo in the centre until the oils are released and the chorizo is lightly browned.
- Add the garlic and smoked paprika, stir into the onions and chorizo and then pour in the tomatoes. Simmer on a medium heat for

5 minutes, then add the rice, stock, lemon zest, pepper and bay leaves. Mix everything together and bring gently to the boil. Put the lid on and cook over a very low heat for 12 minutes.

3. Remove from the heat and leave to sit with the lid on for 10-15 minutes. Stir in the parsley and serve with the lemon wedges.
