WHY YOU **SHOULD GO** WILD FOR **A CRUISE IN SOUTH AFRICA**

A couple of years ago a friend revealed she and her husband were planning a safari adventure in South Africa so naturally I asked (because I am always trying to convert people to the cause) why they didn't combine it with a cruise. She thought I was joking.

really wasn't. We were talking about Africa but there are all sorts of wildlife cruises - around the Galápagos Islands, in the Seychelles, in Costa Rica and even on Silversea's remote cruises in the Russian Far East.

But back to South Africa. Our conversation coincidentally took place just after my own whistlestop cruise-safari - a great trip if not without incident (the funniest of which had to be when the crew hit a water hydrant on the quay in Cape Town and all those of us expecting prime views during the sail away got soaked by a geysir instead!) that opened up a whole new world for me.

I had a day in Cape Town, which was enough to see a little of the city and get a glimpse of Table Mountain and Robben Island, where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned for 27 years.

In Port Elizabeth, I went to one of the townships and a local school to see what life is like and hear what they are trying to do to improve education for the children. Many of us found it an emotional experience. Others joined a tour to Addo Elephant Park and came back with wonderful stories of all the wildlife they had seen.

Next stop was Richards Bay, where we headed off to Hluhluwe Game Reserve in search of elephants, rhinos, buffalos, lions and leopards. It was a brilliant excursion but sadly my last day on safari and on the cruise - as I had to head to Durban for a flight back to London.

It was a sweet but all too short introduction to South Africa, which explains why I have been eyeing up Azamara Club Cruises®' new countryintensive South Africa cruise-safaris.

There are five 10-night voyages at the start and end of next year, all sailing from Cape Town to Port Elizabeth, Richards Bay, Durban and East London and including two days on board back in Cape Town.

James Martin's Scotch Egg With Homemade Vegetable Crisps

P&O Cruises take their gastronomic fare to the next level with their 'Food Heroes' experience, available on board select sailings. One of the nation's favourite chefs, James Martin has been a popular cookery host on a variety of television programmes and P&O Cruises' *Britannia* is home to his own inspired Cookery Club, where guests can learn a range of skills. One such dish that you might hope to create is James Martin's Scotch Egg with Homemade Vegetable Crisps. But why not try the recipe before you join the class so that you can wow James with your culinary skills?

Ingredients (serves four)

- 6 medium eggs
- 400g skinless Lincolnshire sausages
- 50g plain flour, seasoned with salt and black pepper
- 100g fresh breadcrumbs
- 1 large sweet potato, peeled and finely sliced
- 2 medium potatoes, peeled and finely sliced
- 2 raw beetroots, finely sliced
- 2 carrots, finely sliced
- 1 jar of piccalilli, to serve

Method

- 1. Heat a deep-fat fryer to 160°C/320°F.
- Put four of the eggs into a pan of boiling water and simmer for five minutes until they are softboiled. Drain and place in a bowl of iced water

for 10 minutes until cold. Crack the shells, then peel. Crack the remaining two eggs into a bowl and beat lightly.

- 3. Divide the sausage meat into four equal portions and wrap each piece around a soft-boiled egg, pressing gently but firmly to ensure the meat covers the egg completely. Roll first in the seasoned flour, then in the beaten egg and finally in the breadcrumbs. Set aside in the fridge for 30 minutes to chill, then reshape to ensure the meat clings tightly around the egg.
- Drop them into the deep-fat fryer and cook for seven to eight minutes until golden and the meat is cooked through. Drain on kitchen paper and set aside while you cook the crisps.
- Drop the sliced vegetables into the fryer in batches and cook for two to three minutes until cooked through and golden. Drain on kitchen paper and season with salt and pepper.
- 6. Cut the Scotch Eggs in half and serve with some piccalilli and the vegetable crisps.
