Jennie Bond, TV Presenter, Royal Broadcaster, Journalist & ROL Cruise Ambassador speaks to us about why Cunard are her cruise line of choice when it comes to traditional cruising...

1 Hi Jennie! Can you describe the unique details of the Cunard experience and what you think makes them so special?

Hello, of course! There is something very special about stepping on board one of the Cunard "Queens". For my husband Jim and I, it's rather like coming home. 2 Which is your favourite Cunard Queen and why?

We love all three ships. We are particularly partial to the two smaller

ones, *Victoria* and *Elizabeth*, but *Queen Mary 2* is wonderfully grand in every way! You can certainly do your 10,000 steps a day simply by walking to and from your stateroom a few times!

3 Cunard are famed for their White Star Service, what are your experiences of this?

The White Star Service means that the staff on board are trained to look after you in a way that exceeds your expectations. And they all do it with a smile. From your butler to your waiter, your sommelier to the entertainment team, the crew seem to be on a mission to make you feel pampered. And they are very successful. Nothing is too much trouble. You can breakfast in your PJs on the balcony, you can enjoy tea and dainty sandwiches brought to you as you laze in the comfort of your poolside sun lounger, you can learn to paint or play bridge or dance the tango – everything seems possible!



4 What can guests expect from the cuisine on board?

We have always found the food on board to be first class. The main restaurants are extremely elegant and the menus are extensive without being overwhelming. The staterooms are larger, the balconies bigger, the sun loungers squashier. The Queen's and Princess Grills are in a separate part of the ship, with their own exclusive lounge where delicious canapés are served each evening before dinner. Yes, we crossed the Atlantic on the old *QE2* and have also made the voyage on *Queen Mary*. It takes six days and is a unique experience. This is where Cunard's comprehensive and varied entertainment programme makes all the difference. There is so much to do on board that your days can be as busy or as relaxing as you want. Being at sea for nearly a week creates a different atmosphere: a feeling of real camaraderie; it's as if you're all enjoying a huge house party, miles from civilisation, seemingly alone on the high seas. There is something impossibly romantic about dancing to a live band in a grand ballroom as you sail across the Atlantic.

8 Cunard offer exceptional 'Signature Cunard Experiences', do you have any stand-out moments from your time on board?

There have been so many magical moments. Perhaps one of the most memorable was sailing past the tiny island of Stromboli, off the coast of Sicily, with its volcano glowing red in the night sky following a recent eruption. It was an eerie sight.

9 Customers may be suffering under the misconception that Cunard are 'stuffy' and 'too formal', how would you dispel these rumours?

Well, I spend most of my days in a pair of shorts or a swimsuit. Nothing too stuffy about that! In the evenings, people do dress up a bit, but there are only two or three formal evenings on an average voyage. The rules have been relaxed so men can wear a lounge suit instead of a tuxedo on those evenings, and on other nights they don't even have to wear a tie. I find most of us women rather enjoy the chance to glam up, but as long as you look presentable, no-one is going to fuss. And if you prefer to stay in your shorts, you can always eat in the Lido. Sometimes, Jim and J just relax in our stateroom and ask our butler to bring dinner to us on the balcony. Pure indulgence!

There are two things you have to do when visiting Vienna. The first is to visit a local restaurant for a Wiener Schnitzel; a pork or veal cutlet breaded and served with potato salad or fries. The second is to attend a Mozart and Strauss concert in one of the city's palaces.

Ye ticked off the first and now I am sitting in the ballroom of the magnificent Liechtenstein City Palace, listening as an orchestra plays waltzes, polkas and the stirring Radetzky March, while admiring the seriouslyopulent gold leaf and stucco on the walls and ceiling all around me.

The evening is just one of several special highlights of this river cruise l'm on – a 15

day Magnificent Europe cruise from Budapest to Amsterdam on APT's river cruise ship *AmaBella*.

Still to come is an excursion to Salzburg on the Majestic Imperator, a replica of a train built back in the 1800s for Emperor Franz-Joseph, the ruler of the vast Austro-Hungarian Empire, and his wife, the Empress Elisabeth.

It was a journey fit for a king, with red carpets,





sparkling wine and carriages decorated with inlaid wood panels, drapes, upholstered chairs and thick carpets – but I'm afraid you'll have to be quick to experience it because the Imperator will be replaced next year with a day out on the Grand Empress Steam Train from Budapest.

The Grand Empress Steam Train, available from April to September, promises to be at least as grand. It is named in honour of Empress Elisabeth and will take passengers to Gödöllö Palace, one of her favourite residences, gifted to her and her husband when they were crowned King and Queen of Hungary. The journey there takes just under two hours so there's time for a three-course lunch with wine on board. You'll find more information about it elsewhere in this month's edition of Blue Horizons.

Budapest, where my cruise began, is truly grand, boasting the oldest underground railway in Europe after London, the largest Jewish synagogue in Europe and the third-largest parliament building in the world (it is trumped by the Palace of the Parliament in Bucharest and the Palace of Westminster in London).

The first time I visited it was still under Communist rule and very grey and unloved. Restaurants had tempting menus but no food and the streets were empty. Now it is buzzing with people, cars, restaurants and cafés serving everything from burgers to tasty Hungarian goulash.

A morning tour took us past the synagogue and parliament, and stopped at Heroes Square, built in 1896 to mark Hungary's 1,000th Anniversary, and Fisherman's Bastion, a lookout spot with great views of the river below.

From Budapest we set sail for Vienna, the city from where Emperor Franz-Joseph and his Habsburg ancestors once ruled their vast empire. It is also one of my favourite cities, a joyous place to see everything from opulent palaces and elegant coffee houses to priceless art collections and the white Lipizzaner horses.

One of the lovely things about cruising with APT, is that as well as including all excursions in the cost of the cruise, there is a choice

of tours most days so you can dip in and out of what appeals without worrying about the budget. Fares also include flights and transfers, gratuities, Wi-Fi and all meals on board.

On *AmaBella*, one of four APT river ships sailing the Magnificent Europe cruise next year, the main restaurant is divided into two sections each evening, with an international menu served on one side and an Italian-themed choice of dishes on the other. There is also a speciality restaurant, Chef's Table, with seating for up to 24 diners, at the back.

We all went to the Mozart and Strauss concert during an overnight stay in Vienna but the next day, while I opted for a tour to the Spanish Riding School, others took an excursion to Schönbrunn Palace, the summer home of the Habsburgs, and others still headed out of the city to Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia.

This really turned out to be the cruise that never stops giving. Over the course of two weeks we sailed on four waterways (the Danube, Main-Danube Canal, Main River and Rhine), transited the picturesque Wachau Valley and Rhine Gorge, sailed over the Franconian Alps and negotiated 68 locks.

We visited opulent abbeys, palaces and medieval towns, saw the chilling Nazi parade grounds in Nuremberg, met a real German princess, Heide von Hohenzollern, in her very



own castle and learnt about canals, clogs and windmills in the Netherlands.

From Deggendorf, I joined guide Sylvia for a tour around the medieval centre of Regensburg, one of the few towns to escape the Second World War bombings as there was no industry there to destroy.

It's a lovely town, with narrow medieval streets, towers built by wealthy individuals for no reason other than to show off just how rich they were (the higher the tower, the wealthier you were), and the oldest sausage kitchen in the world, which is my top recommendation for a bratwurst and beer at lunchtime.

The city also has a beautiful 12th century stone bridge that is still intact today. According to legend, the stonemason made a bet with his counterpart building the cathedral that he would finish first but when it looked like he might lose, he appealed to the devil for help to win the wager. In return, he agreed with the devil that he could take the first three souls to cross the bridge.

It actually took just 11 years to build, which was incredibly quick (especially given a renovation has just taken seven years!), but not fast enough and the stonemason lost the bet. However, he came up with a cunning plan to foil the devil, shooing a hen, rooster and dog across the bridge ahead of any people. I guess you could say the devil had been, cluckolded.

THE MOAI ORIGINS

The UNESCO World Heritage Site of Rano Raraku is a volcanic quarry where most of the island's iconic Moai were created. Marvel at these huge basalt monoliths as you walk amongst hundreds of specimens in various stages of completion. Some stand proud at four metres tall, others are unfinished and abandoned, while the 21-metre El Gigante lies where it was carved, most likely too heavy to lift. See where archaeologists have transformed protruding heads by uncovering their buried bodies, then admire Tukuturi, the island's only kneeling statue.

VOLCANOES & BIRDMEN

On the southwest tip of the island is Rano Kau, an extinct volcano filled with a freshwater lake. Walk around much of the mile-wide crater for outstanding views, both out to sea and into its dramatic flora-lined caldera. At the point where its slopes meet the cliff edge, explore the archaeological ruins of the Orongo ceremonial village. During the 18th and 19th centuries, the 53 windowless stone houses were home to the Tangata Manu (birdmen) who competed annually to retrieve a tern egg from nearby Motu Nui islet. Numerous petroglyphs carved into the rocks are thought to celebrate its winners.

CHOCOLATE & RAISIN BREAD

with Whisky Sauce

INGREDIENTS

Whisky Sauce:

- 1 1/2 cups heavy cream
- 2 teaspoons cornstarch
- 1 tablespoon cold water
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons whisky, such as Jack Daniels, Jameson or Old Bushmills

Bread Pudding:

- 1/2 cup golden raisins
- 2 tablespoons whisky (for soaking the raisins; optional)
- 1 pound loaf day-old Italian bread, cut into 1 inch cubes
- 1/2 cup chocolate chips
- 6 large eggs
- 2 pints whole milk
- 1 cup sugar
- · 3 tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder, sifted
- 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla
- 1/4 teaspoon salt

METHOD

Whisky Sauce:

 In a heavy saucepan, heat the cream over a medium heat until it boils. In a small bowl, whisk the cornstarch and water; whisk this mixture into the boiling cream. Return the cream to the boil then reduce the heat to low and cook, stirring for 30 seconds, taking care not to let the mixture burn. Add the sugar and whisky and stir until the sugar is dissolved. Immediately remove from the heat and let cool to room temperature. Cover and store in the refrigerator until ready to use. Reheat before serving.

Bread Pudding:

- 1. Heat the oven to 350°F/180°C. Grease a 12 case muffin tin. Combine the raisins and whisky in a small bowl; let sit for at least 15 minutes.
- Bring a large kettle of water to the boil. Drain the raisins and discard the liquid. Divide the bread, chocolate chips, and drained raisins among the muffin cups.
- In a large bowl, combine the eggs, milk, sugar, cocoa powder, vanilla, and salt. Whisk to blend thoroughly.
- Pour the egg mixture over the bread in each of the muffin cups and place the pan in a large roasting pan.
- Transfer the roasting pan to the oven and add enough boiling water to the large pan to reach halfway up the side of the muffin tray.
- 6. Bake the puddings for 30 to 40 minutes or until puffed and just set.
- 7. Once cooked, let the bread pudding cool until warm and serve with the whisky sauce, whipped cream and vanilla ice cream.
