

Cabin Notes

- All adapted cabins have a shower only, with the exception of Suites/Mini-suites which have standard bath and separate shower. The following cabins C194, C203, C1, C2, E95, E96, G11, G12, G74, G81 and G82 are suitable for un-confined wheelchair access, however, please be aware that opening the door from within the cabin will require assistance from an able-bodied companion.

Note: All pull-down beds in twin cabins are accessible via a ladder. When pull-down beds are in use, lower beds cannot be converted to a double. Balconies in the forward section of the ship can be overlooked by the bridge.
